Course-Related Library Instruction

Faculty are encouraged to request a hands-on instruction session for their course with a faculty librarian in one of the Library's computer instruction rooms. Classes can be tailored to fit the needs of your students, including particular assignments. Library Courses

The Library offers two courses designed to improve students' information literacy skills. These are highly recommended for students at any level.

LS A101 (offered Fall, Spring, and Summer)

Library Resources and Information Retrieval is a one-credit, self-paced online introduction to academic library research with an emphasis on electronic resources. Students should have physical access to a library, preferably academic, to complete this course.

LS A211 (offered Fall and Spring)

Library Research in the 21st Century is a three-credit course that is both broader and more in depth than LS A101.

RefWorks

The Library offers this online research management tool for storing and sharing references, as well as producing in-text citations and bibliographies.
