PNC Adopts Wild Apricot Web Hosting



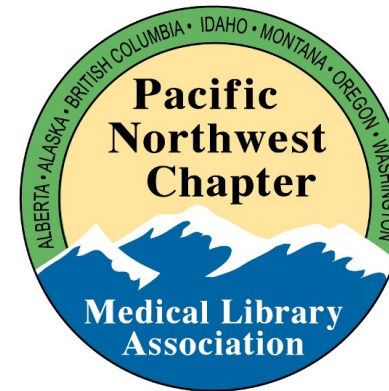

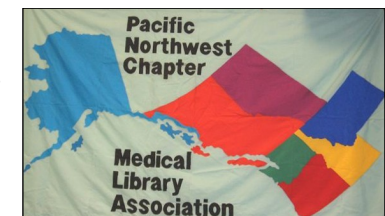
