Send small box cigars to Dr. Scholeben.

Cool & cloudy.

Mon. May 21st 1917

Found out the boat would not leave for three or four days. Did some more buying of supplies. At dinner with Mr. Wanamaker, & saw Mr. & Mrs. Hodenfile off on the boat for Seattle and spent the evening at Mrs. Wanamakers with Miss Watt. Mr. Edes in on *Evons*? today.

Tues. May 22 1917

Took walk to above Chester Cr. A.M. Had baggage taken over to dock PM. Joe Mecham came in from Rainbow to take a residency in the Talkeetna District. Cloudy & cool.

Wed May 23rd 1917

Down to Com. P.M. but did nothing about getting supplies out. Went to Dentist. Evening went for walk with Mrs. W.

Cool & cloudy.

Clear & cool tonight.

Thur. May 24th 1917

Got out Requisitions & packed stationary chest at Warehouse. Called on Mrs. W. this evening. Took long walk with Miss Watt after 9:30 PM. She is a real live wire. *Alaska* in & out tonight.

Light rain P. M.

Fri. May 25th

Transcripts.

Requisitioned Hardware & paint & tagged all parcels A.M. Read in Labor Union Reading Room PM. Rool? & Show Evening. Cloudy & cold with wind.

Sat. May 26th 1917.

Took walk down past com. grounds & stopped at Office. P.M. went out to Lake Spenard with Miss Watt and Mrs. Wanamaker. Took lunch & made coffee over a campfire. Had fine time. Miss W. I guess was was rather bored at times. Clear & warm. Heard "A" line of Mr. Secrists was approved by Mr. Mears & Mr. Hansen so will probably go through. Cliff Weir quit & 83 & come to Anchorage & will go out with Joe Mechom as rodman.

Sun. May 27 1917

Down to Com. grounds A.M. & learned that boat would leave at 3 P.M. Tues. Ate lunch with Mrs. W. then went with Miss Watts to baseball game. First game City 4 Matanuska 2 Second game, 5 innings only Com. 11 Turnagain Arm 2. After She had never before seen a game of baseball. After the game we went for a walk out to Mr. Ossiers where we called then returned at supper at Aunts? & she went to church. Fine visit good day. Evening called on Jack Taylor's family over on Gov Hill. Cloudy & cool.

Mon. 5-28-17

Farraguat in. Agrreed to trade men with Joe M. Called on Mrs. W & took pictures over to her. She is now wanting to leave but cannot sell for enough to lether? come out ahead on the deal.

Beautiful Day.

Tues. 5-29-17

Went to dentist & had crown reset A. M. Left on Omineco? at 3 P.M. for Talkeetna. On board are Joe Mecham & party, Max Kinney & party, myself & party, Judge Brown, Marshall Brennemon? & several clerks & timekeepers for the Talkeetna District. Tonight we are entering Susitna River. Fine day. Mrs. W. was at the boat.

Wed. 5-30-17

Arrived at Susitna Station about 1 P.M. & got away about four P.M. This is an old Indian Village & Trading post.
River very high & rising. Light Rain

Thur. 5-31-17

Arrived Kroto? About 10 A.M. & lay here all day unloading freight & transferring the load from the Omineco? to the B & B boats. Both boats loaded tonight ready to start at 5 A.M. River still rising. There are no buildings at Kroto? landing. It is only a sheltered landing place and will be used by the commission this year as a transfer point.

Fine day. Are making very slow time.

Transcripts.

Fri. 6-1-17

Made very slow time because of swift water. In many place [sic: places] we could barely make headway. Figured on getting to Montana Creek tonight but had to tie up at a point about two miles below. Fine weather.

Sat. -6-2-17

Got to Montana Cr. about 7. A. M. Max Kinney & party left the boat here. Several of us also left the boat & walked to Talkeetna about 16 miles. I started out alone but caught up with U. S. Marshall Brennaman, Mr. Townsend, & Mr. Fordice. We walked slow. I left them about two miles from town & came in alone. Got log out of trap? Saw Mr. Dose & found that I would be stationed at mile 34 but would not get away for a few days. B & B #1 in about 8 P.M. & #2 not in tonight. Bunked in the jail with Townsend Crefean? & Fordyce. Fine Day.

Sun. 6-3-17

B.B. #2 in about 4 A.M. B.B. #1 left up river for Dead Horse Hill at 5:30 A.M. & B & B #1 left here for Kroto at 10:30 A.M. Marshall & Judge went back. Most of the clerks went up to Dead Horse Hill.

Mon. 6-4-17.

B & B #1 returned going down about 11. P.M. last night & left here again going down at 5 A.M. today. Notes & profiles comes down from D.H. Boys hung & sharpened axes. Gott & I adjusted level & copied some note. Light rain all day.

Tues. 6-5-1917.

Around camp A.M. Bough & I took walk up grade about 5 ½ miles P.M. & I also walked to camp 221 to get some B. M's & ate supper there. Met Conty & Holsgate Light showers P.M.

Wed. 6-6-17

Around camp A.M. P.M. Gott, Petterson & I took two blankets each & walked to camp 234 at which place we will be located. The rock is poor & we got arrived there at about 6. PM. leaving here at 1:45. Camp just being put up & we slept on ground on boughs.

Cloudy.

Thur 6-7-17.

Staked R.W. for Gorwell & Co's contract & went up line away. Bunks are in tonight. Mr. Ralph Kinney came in from Dead Horse Hill about 7 P.M. Met him for first time. Like him well. Fri. –6-8-17

Walked to Talkeetna with Mr. Kinney. Let Gott & Petterson to build another bunk in tent. Word came from Headquarters at Anchorage to not let anymore contracts north of

Talkeetna. Both B & B boats are disabled and unable to get grub up river. Mr. Dose & bunch of men came down tonight from Dead Horse. Mr. Dose says to stake RW make stake recross section near Lone Cr. on upper end of residency where stakes were washed out. He will send lumber down from D. Horse on first boat down. Cloudy. Planting potatoes

Sat 6-9-17

Bough, Armstrong & Cufaugh? took packs beds & axes & walked to 234. left about 8:45 B & B #2 was to g down river with with about 50 men including Mr. Dose & Mr. Kinney at 9:30 AM. but orders came to stay here until Sunday noon as the Omineco? was still in Anchorage. No news from B & B No 1. Stuck about camp all P.M. Quite warm & light clouds.

Sun. 6-10-17.

B & B #2 left for Kroto at 1:30 P.M. Had boys come back from 234 because Mr. D. said it would probably be several days before a boat went up the river & that we had better pack our stuff up to camp About fifty went down on the boat. A bunch of us were at the Indian camp this P. M. I took a picture of a squaw Michole & a bunch of children. Walked down to 221 & back. (inserted bottom to top on left side of page: Gave Cks to Mr Dose to transfer my savings acct to Bk. of Alaska.) J. & J. stuck on a bar opposite 221 at 3 P.M. but in here 7 P.M.

Thunder shower, PM

Mon. 6-11-17

The whole forty packed the personal belongings we needed for the next few weeks & mushed to this camp #234 Ate lunch at 232 & reached camp about 3:30 P.M. All are in one tent & will be until we get the permenent summer tents up. Light shower. Fine day.

Tues. 6-12-17

Gott, Peterson & Armstrong staked R.W. from 10565 to 10715 Crepeaw? & Bough cut stakes. I walked over line noting its location with respect to side hill & river from 10665 to 10765. Pack train of seven horses went up to Dead Horse with grub but left? here. We are about out. First clear day since I left the Arm Mt. McKinley was in plain sight this morning. Phone Sachs? about notebooks of + sections on about monthly estimates. Also got Employment Agreements & Personal Records completed & ready to send to Dead Horse.

Wed. -6-13-17

Cut stakes & staked R.W. I walked over line from camp to 10290 noting especially the nature of the ground along the slides where cribs are proposed. Only meat in camp is some codfish. Pack train here from Talkeetna late tonight. Clear day. River rose a little.

Thur. 6-14-17

Transcripts.

Bough & Crefan? cut stakes all day at 10655 Gott, Peterson & Armstrong staked R.W. A.M. & cut stakes at 10591 PM. A.M. I walked over line N. of camp and P.M. walked up to Cashe Cr. (10592) & back by way of upper trail noted chance for borrow Pit at Cashe Cr. & considerable spruce & birch above river. Mr. Kinney showed tonight that Mr. Dose had sent word to have my party disband & go to Anchorage. Cloudy shower tonight I hear that Joe Mecham will go out also.

Fri. 6-15-17

Boys in camp all AM. I took walk over line from camp to 10715 noting chance for Borrow pit. P.M. Boys cleared underbrush near camp. Bough & I dug test pits in point at 10663 & found gravel on river side & sand on hill side. B. & B. #1 in Talkeetna tonight.

Showery all day.

Sat 6-16-17

In camp all day. Mr. Kinney went through on way to Dead Horse Hill A.M. His personal advise [sic: advice] is to stay with the commission even if one's position is lowered. B & B #1 passed here on way up about 2 P.M. We expect it back tonight or tomorrow morning & will go down on her. Pack train & of 11 horses went down today. Clear & warm. B & B #1 did not stop for us so we had to unpack our beds again. B & B #3 will go up tomorrow morning & come get us on the way down.

Sun. 6-17-17

Packed up & went down to end of point to wait for B & B #3. She came along & went on past so we thought she had been instructed at the last moment not to stop. We took our beds back again & I unpacked took a bath in the Cr. & when I got back she was coming back up river for us She came up to camp took off some lumber & took us down. Ate supper at Talkeetna & went on down. Stopping at Montana Cr & Browers Cashe In to Kroto at 11:30 PM.

Mon. 6-18-17

Lay at Kroto transferring freight until about 6 P.M. Then came down river. Mosquitoes thick at K. Fine ride down.

Tues. 6-19-17

Arrived at Anchorage 6. A.M. At 3:30 PM. learned that party is to be disbanded, men transferred to go back to old jobs and new men to be time checked. All dissaponited [sic: disappointed] but we were prepared for anything. Fine day. Will get away for Turnagain Arm Thursday. Not many people in Anchorage.

Wed. 6-20-17

Made Pay Roll Discharge papers, etc. Saw Mr. Oliver arranged for having tools checked Saw dentist. Visited Miss Watts tonight. Long walk out to Osier's & back on R. R. Miss W. is now runs Rooming House.

Clear & Warm.

Thur. 6-21-17

Go back to camp 83. To Potter by train & to 83 by boat. Fine day. In camp about 9:30 P.M.

Fri. -6-22-17

Plotted CL? from 1770 to 1850 & ck'd Teko's Final Estimate.

Cloudy & windy. Large force working line. Camp cleaned up. Saur? in Anchorage to bring his family out. Subscribed for *Anchorage Times* & for *Seattle Times*.

Sat. -6-23-17.

Teko's estimate out today. Bal Party run // line & stake borrow pit for Mouzri.? cloudy & windy Bentley & Stimpson left.

Sun. 6-24-17

Washed & cleaned up. Found small chest soaked with water leached through the can of hypo? & all the letters & books wet & a big bunch of pictures ruined dried the letters & some pictures & cleaned up the mess. Cloudy. Clarence Stubb? & Barnard went to Glacier.

Mon. 6-25-17

Work in office all day. Mat & bunch gave grades part of day. Rain all day.

Tues 6-26-17

Ran CL between A1465 & A1472 where the stakes had been burned out. Saw boys from Glacier who said they expected a train out from Seward to Kern Cr. Thursday. Rain all day Foresters fixing up tent next to ours.

Wed. 6-27-17

Ran CL & gave Grad [sic: grade] at 1712 and Ran CL from 1763 to 1767 + 50. Measured Mazarins Borrow for June estimate Barnard was let go and Major White and Smith were taken on as axmen. No Rain fine day.

Thur. 6-28-17

Measured material in tents at Camp 82 and at So? Camp and set stakemarking tide at landing.

No much doing now.

No Rain cloudy.

Fri. 6-29-17

Office work. Bal. Party in field. Monthly reports finished today. Ligh Showers.

Sat. 6-30-17

Ran CL & set stakes at lower edge of Road Bed 1731 to 1742 A.M. Mr. Secrist left for Potter Cr. AM.

P.M. Matt, Stubb & Clarence went to Anchorage. White, Smith & I made shelf for rolls under drafting table, and loafed. Light Showers.

Sun. 7-1-17

In Camp all day. Light showers.

Mon. 7-2-17

Office all day. Met Miss Georgia McManus? & we agreed to go to Anchorage to the celebration of the Fourth together. We left in launch Vivian about 7 P.M. Stuck on mud 15 minutes & had to get all hands over board to get launch off. Just got off & propeller rope broke. Ran into high sea & were late on the tide so had to stop at Sheep Cr. Miss Mc borrowed Mr. Stanfords uniform & rode horse to Potter Cr. She stayed with Leaches tonight. Fair day.

Tues. 7-3-17

Came into Anchorage on train.

Supper, Show & Dance. Fine time.

Wed. 7-4-17.

Parade, Athiettes A.M., Baseball PM Miss Mc got acquainted with Mr. Reynolds last night and seemed to fall hard for him. He went to dinner with us today and after dinner I had him go over to take her to the ball game. I called at Mrs. Wanamakers, she was not home, I went over to th [sic: the] game & was late so got no seat. Then called on Miss Watts at her Rooming house had good visit with her until about 5:30 & went up & got Miss Mc to go to supper. We went up the street to find Sam & see Mrs. Leach.& Maude. Found both of them & ran into Reynolds who went to supper with us. R. is a fine fellow, a gentlemen. we took her home to get ready for the dance. R. & I smoked a few cigarettes in my room then he went to his room & & I over to get Miss. Mc. Had three dances with her during the evening & let Reynolds take her home. This will be heard from later. Had a fine time, however.

Thur. 7-5-17.

Ball game this P.M. Went to dentist A.M. & had tooth crowned again. Later crown came loose. Dr. Rystrom? advised leaving it as it was. Consulted Dr. German and & he advised extracting broken root, which I had him do. Miss Mc & Mr. R. returned to her room to get her & we three went to ball game. Potter Cr. 10, City 0. Left Anchorage at 6 P.M. for Rabbit Caboose Observation car five flats. Left Potter at 8 P. M. on *Vivian* for 83. Tide was going out too strong to make 83 so we stopped at Rainbow Cr. In Thur at 10:30 PM Lunch at 11 PM & out good beds. Got wind of comments of women concerning my not taking Mc home last night.

Friday 7-6-17.

Transcripts.

Up at 3:45 & on boat. Into 83 at 5:45. All well tired out. Sam Estes came back with us & is about all done up. Slept A.M. Went out & staked ditch for Sam P.M. at 1765 Fine day.

Sat. 7-7-17.

Ran CL & grades for Paoletich? & ran // line on lower side of Morgan's cut. A.M. I worked on book and rest loafed P.M. Called at Sam's 45. Warm day. Clarence Stubb came back this morning.

Sun. 7-8-17

In Camp all AM. Took walk alone P.M. Fine Day. Got word of more laborers to be let go this week.

Mon. 7-9-17

Boys cut wood & worked around Mr. Secrists place. I wan in office all day, (G. 75°) Fine day.

Tues. 7-10-17

Office all day with two hrs. work. All loafing in camp. Rain all day. No G.

Wed. 7-11-17

Rain all day & all of us stayed in. Made two checker boards A.M. Talked & read. G. A. 75°

Thur. 7-12-17

Boys cut wood A. M. & I ck'd non expendable list. P.M. Stubb & Smith cut wood & rest of us ran ch. levels and and checked grade points from 1690 to 1765. No. Rain cloudy & windy. Dr. Scholeber here tonight. Sam up but pretty weak. No G.

Fri 7-13-17

Rain all day & all loafing. Worked on notes A.M. & a little PM. Had callers P.M. Called on Sam Estes tonight. His is very sick and weak G. 80°

Sat. 7-14-17

Measured up Com. crest 1765 to 1767+18 cut stakes & ran ck. levels to 1798. A.M. Cut stakes and figured out yardage in cut P.M.

After supper took walk up to top of the schute [sic: chute]. Called on Sam Estes tonight. He is much better. G. A. 80°.

Light Showers.

Sun 7-15-17

Miss McM & I went for a walk up the track. to about mile 86. Jack Jian, Mr. Bose & Mr. Kelsey came down this A.M. for a visit. Showers all day. G. A. 80°

Mon. 7-16-17.

Walter Todd Diary D; May 1917-January 1918.

Transcripts.

Set Stakes for gridiron at boat landing A.M. P.M. Matt went to Collins. Clarence White & Smith cut stakes. Mr. S & I walked down to landing and loafed. Sam felt good this morning & walked over to Commissary. When he got home was all in & had to go to bed. Showers all day. Strathcona? in camp today & tonight.

Tues. 7-17-17

Matt & I went up to boat landing A.M. & P.M. cross sectioned cut & set some guide stakealong channel. Sam walked up there PM. Boy banked tent Light Showers P.M.

Tom McKinney came up last night & went back today.

Wed 7-18-17

At landing all day Boys banked Mr. S's tent & excavated for a woodshed for him. Boy master tonight. Mr. Mears & Mr. Hansen were supposed to be here tonight but wind was too high. Fine AM. Showers PM.

Thru. 7-19-17

Walked to landing AM. No one working on grid. Went to landing & gave grade for one sill. Boys built woodshed for Mr. S.

Mr. Mears & Mr. Hansen got to camp early this A.M. & left before noon. Drew sketch for cut & dock last night & added a little tonight.

G. A. 80°.

Rainy all day

Fri. 7-20-17

Ran CL in stretches from 1693 to 1725. Payed [sic: paid] \$50.00 on 50 shares computing machine stock @ \$3.00 per share. All resident engineers & a lot of others bought stock. They left machine here. Jack Taylor in camp tonight. He say Mr. Mears is trying to get permission to raise 3000 men for a const Regiment. G. A. 75° & TK. No Rain

Sat 7-21-17

Ran CL & ck'd grades & cut stakes. Mc 40° late PM 75° No Rain

Sun. 7-22-17

Walked to Kern Cr. & back with Paddy McCormick. Stopped at Glacier going and coming. Ate supper & the way back.

During the year that I have been away things have changed wonderfully. All the cuts but the one at the snowslide are nearly out. The fill across the Glacier Cr. marsh as [sic: has] settled about three ft and will probably settle more. The Kern Cr. bridge is up and steel is layed [sic: laid] across it about ¾ of a mile. Glacier Cr. bridge is driven &

capped and the other small pile bridges are driven. However, work seems to be going slow on that end.

Met Mr. Keller & he seems to be a perfect gentleman. They talk of having all the work to Bird Point but I think they are dreaming. It rained all the forenoon & we were throughly [sic: thoroughly] wet when we got to Glacier. Came back fast way? beach & were dry when we got in to camp. M. Mc & M to 86 & K. 70°

Mon 7-23-17

Mr. S & I walked out on mud flat A.M. & note where channel changes are to be made. He left for Anchorage just after dinner. I was at landing P.M. Boys worked on changes in their tent. Warm A.M. Rain P.M.

Tues. 7-24-17

Cross-sectioned channel changes.

Men started digging ditches.

Mrs. Hilford & Mrs. Secrest were in today telling a little current stuff. It's good! Some came with Rhentism? Tonight.

Miss McManus honored us with her company at supper.

Raining.

Wed. 7-25-17

Went up to Colins camp & stayed to

Dinner. C. came back with me.

Boys made stakes A.M. Matt at gride P.M.

Taffy pull tonight. Good time

A.M. 75°

Rain all day

Thur. 7-26-17

Rain AM Took readings for monthly estimates in Mcquri's? & Paveltich's cats & measured material in dock & warehouse Looked at channel changes in plats Cut stakes Mr. S. returned tonight called at S. A. [Anchorage] 40° (gave [unreadable] sure all in bal) Trembly here tonight. Got acquainted with Martin the asst timekeeper tonight he is an Oxford man & math wizzard [sic: wizard].

Fri. 7-27-17

Changed slope stakes figured monthy [sic:monthly] estimates & made stakes & cut wood for Mr. S.

Card Party tonight at Commissary.

A 60°

No Rain Clear tonight.

Sat 7-28-17

Arranged to go to Anchorage & did figure. Collin's Clearing.

Transcripts.

<u>Asked</u> G. to go to town & she said she would go then changed & said she would not because Sam did not want her to go. Later she decided she would & [unreadable word] Miss. Leach that [sic: that] she would be there.

So we left here about 8:30 & got a boat at

10 P.M. getting into Potter at 1 AM

Sun. 7-29-17

Special train went to Anchorage from Potter to se [sic: see] the base ball game. We got in about 11 A.M. & got dinner & went to game P.M. Seward beat 4 to 3 12th inning. It is reported that Anchorage lost \$12000.00 on the game. I took G. with Mr. L & M.

Mon. 7-30-17

G & I went to game alone. Seward beat 7 to 0

Tues. 7-31-17

Anchorage won 7 to 6 11th inning good game. Dance tonight. G. pretty gal. Saw Mrs. Wanamaker & Miss Watts & ate lunch with Miss Watts. Mrs. Leach & Maude came in the morning & G went down to meet them.

Wed 8-1-17

Came back to camp. left A [Anchorage] at 10 AM ate dinner at Potter, left here at 3 P.M. went to Kern Cr. & back to 83 after supper. G wanted to stay at Potter to play tennis or to loose [sic: lose] sight of me probably the latter However she did want to stay & play tennis. Dan & Hansen josh me tonight about it.

Thur. 8-2-17

Ran CL [centerline] from 1692 to 1712 & started to set finishing stake. About 2 PM we quit to help fight fire in the woods back & s out [sic: out] of the 82 Camp. The fire started about noon and gain great head way with the high wind through dry brush & moss. All the men in camp turned out to help fight & kept to above the old Alaska Northern R. W. and from getting in the timber below the trail. We (part of us) worked all night until 3 A.M. when the rain started. The sky was clear all day. Mrs. H. & Mr. L went back to Potter this A.M.

Fri. 8-3-17

Slept all fornoon Set finishing stakes P.M.

Light showers all day.

Geo. Trembly in tonight.

Sat. 8-4-17

Ran CL [centerline] & set finishing stakes on [unreadable] work and set corner stakes for Powder House $\frac{for}{for}$ at landing. Bill K went to Potter Cr. & to town .

Clear & warm.

Sun. 8-5-17

Transcripts.

In camp most of day. Took walk up on hill near tie shoot & over old trail to new trail & back to camp by grade.

Clear & windy.

Mon. 8-6-17

Ran CL & set finishing stakes in Swanson's & Paveltich's cuts & finishing stakes Mcries[unreadable] cut & N. fill

Barge load of dinky & dump cars towed by *Alaska* & *Elkutna* tried to get to landing A.M. but failed Tried again on next tide tonight & failed Bill K. returned from Anchorage. Mr. Secrest left for Anchorage by trail tonight. High wind & cloudy. Showers P.M.

Tues. 8-7-17

Did not work on line. Was at landing A.M. & PM watching steam shovel unloading. *Anna W.* brought it in safely on the morning tide. Rainy all day. Geo. came in tonight on launch.

Wed. 8-8-17

Finished setting finishing stakes on [unreadable] fill check notes. Went to landing. Shovel off last night barge with dinky and dump cars in this A.M. tide & unloaded tonight.

Cloudy No Rain Jack Taylor in camp tonight.

Thurs. 8-9-17

Measured most of the old Teko cut AM Matt & I in office & boys cutting stakes P.M. S. called. I Poured cold water.

Walked to landing to meet two boats tonight but neither came.

Taylor in camp tonight Mr. S. returned from town.

Anne [sic: Anna] W. in A.M. with barge of coal

Cloudy

No Rain.

Fri. 8-10-17

Finish measuring the Teko cut & worked in office balance of day on estimate of above cut.

Boat expected in last night arrived this noon. Mr. Thompson & his wife & little boy came in on the *Alaska* & will live here this winter. He will be the "dinky skinner." Taylor left P.M. Doc-Scholeber? came in & went out.

Clear & warm all day No Rain

Sat. 8-11-17

Last night's tide brought in lots of slush ice & left it all over the flat. A cold North wind has been blowing all day & was a high wind by night. A large part of the bridge timbers got loose & drifted up towards shore. Clear & cold tonight with high N. wind.

Alaska tied up at landing.

Mr. Leech boat crew of V[Vibbianna] in camp tonight.

Scottie got third driver in last night & intended locating it on line tonight so he could driver from it

Mon. -10-29-17

Last night's high wind with the high tide carried all the piles & bridge timbers up towards shore braking the rafts and left tie's caps & stringers as well as piles strewn all along the flat from the S. end of the hill to the N. end of the trestle. Most of them we [sic: were] coated with ice. They gathered most of them together again & put some on the top of the bents driver. The middle driver was pushed out of line but managed to drive one permanent and two temp. bents. The N. driver worked P.M. The S. driver worked at hoisting timbers on the deck of the bridge.

Boys. +sec'd

We had lining put in new stove & got it in PM.

Anna W. came in tonight with two scows one with powder & one with spuds & provisions. All the men were got out to help unload it. This A.M was clear but clouds started to gather at noon & snow started to fall about 2:30 PM. & is still coming down another high wind is blowing tonight.

The driver on the S. end hoisted timbers all day. Scottie finished driving 3 bents & got on top. The N. one drove 12 piles & pulled back to start to take up timbers. High wind & tide tonight.

Last nights tide left about two ft. of slush ice all over the flat.

Tonight the ice was so thick in the Arm

that the *Anna W* could not land at 82 until the tide had quit flowing & then only with difficulty.

Mr. Hansen in camp tonight.

Snow fell all last night & all day & is falling tonight. I was in camp most of day.

Wed. -10-31-17

Went to 84 & wired up stove pipe A.M. There was about 12 inches of sluch all over the flat. The two end

drivers worked at hauling bridge timbers to the top of the bridge. Sottie [sic: Scottie] got on top last night & drove 9 piles today. Helped boys +sec. P.M. Snow about 14" deep on level.

Arm full of ice and there was so much at the landing that the Mr. Leech thought it was not safe for any boat to try to get in. The *Anna W &* the *Islander* were out of control in the ice yesterday & drifted up & down with it.

Alaska came & went from 82. Anna W due in tonight.

Fri. -11-2-17

Around camp A.M. Ray & I gave cut offs & spotted piles at S. driver P.M. They drove nine piles & put on two caps. The slush is about 3 ft deep & the water supply is poor. The other two drivers also drove most of P.M.

Ray worked as carpenter Casod & Seinberg left for States toady. Dr. Scholeben in & out.

Cold & clear all day snow tonight.

Tues. 11-6-17.

Drove 15 piles & put on 3 caps. Both the other drivers drove. Mr. Hansen & Mr. Breck went through here on horses tonight on their way to Kern Creek.

Ralph Doseis? came into camp

tonight to work at pile driver in place of Casod who quit to go outside.

Cloudy. 2 in. snow last night.

Wed. 11-7-17

S. driver worked at hauling timbers & piles. Others drove Van & I set a levels site on hill on S. end of tangent and layed up most of the bal. of the day.

Mr. S. made out Backtroms? final estimate of culvert contract. Mr. Hansen returned from Kern Cr. P.M. & is in camp tonight. The first four horse teams came over trail from Rainbow today with a load of meat.

Flurries of snow Mail late tonight.

Thur. -11-8-17

Transcripts.

Drove 20 piles & put on 3 caps. N. drive drove all day & middle driver drove 1 bent & hoisted timber & piles all day.

Four inches snow last night & about 9 inches fell today.

Middle driver hoisted timbers & N. one hoised [sic: hoisted] timbers AM. & drove two bents P.M.

Mat, Mac & Ray referenced points.

Cold N. wind all day clear. 12° 7 AM. 15° Noon & 6 PM.

Sun. 11-11-17

Drove 15 piles from 9 AM to 3 P.M.

Made some pegs. Washed & mended Both other drivers drove.

First mail team of 23 dogs went through toward Anchorage today. They were about worn out & a team carried the mail on a sleigh to 88 from here for them. Snow & wind from S. all day.

Was invited out to Dinner at Mrs. Estes' tonight but declined because of having to work.

Mon. 11-12-17

Drove 15 piles & put on three caps, from 9:30 AM to 3:30 P.M. Scottie drove 2 bents

Ray is making sleds for the kids.

Mr. Leech in camp tonight.

Six cars went over the dump this AM.

Wind & snow all day with temp about 25°

Tues 11-13-17

Drove & capped 4 bents from 9:45 to 4:30.

Both of the other drivers drove.

Temp about 20°

Transcripts.

Snow all PM & tonight.

Decking crew came to camp this noon.

Wed. -11-14-17

Drove 2 complete bents A.M.

Set centers on caps P.M. Both other drivers drove

Mr. Hansen was in camp last night & he & M. L. went down the line today. Seward mail went through with horses this noon. The big problem now is to get piles. They are cutting for the lower driver. The middle one has about 40 left & the S. one about 65

They are going to try to haul them from the landing to , S driver with dinky & from there onto middle driver with teams.

A slide came down over the trail opposite south end of trestle & cover trail 12' deep.

Cloudy & snow about 22°

Thru. -11-15-17

Driver crew worked at hauling timber & pilling all day so Van & I were in camp. Middle driver drover 22 piles & N. one drove only 8 & put on bracing bal. of day. Mr. S. in office AM. & on line P.M.

6" snow last night Big bunch of men came to camp

Women were in to call P.M. all feeling good

Fri. -11-16-17

Drove 25 piles & put on four caps.

Other drivers also drove Scottie drove 26 piles & put on five caps.

Mrs. Estes, Georgeanne & Ray went to Glacier to vote at a school election. They are trying to get a school started there & get Gerogeanne to teach.

Moderate wind from South.

Dan Leech & camp tonight.

Sat -11-17-17

Drove 25 piles

Other drivers drove only part of the day Bridge gang started working on decking the bridge.

Team went over the side of the trail & rolled down hill about 100 ft without injuring them.

Paymaster here tonight

Slightly cloudy & cold.

Sun. -11-18-17

Drove 25 piles

Middle driver hoisted timbers & lower one did same & drove 5 piles.

Rain & Sleet P.M.

Transcripts.

Raining tonight Messrs Gerig, Fleishman, & Engleman stopped here at noon on their way through to Seward to go outside. Mr. Hansen was with them.

Bridge decking crew worked.

Asked Mr. Secrest to hand in my application for membership in the Masonic Lodge.

Mon. 11-19-17

Thur. -11-22-17

Drove 17 piles. Scottie drove 35 & lower rig drove none 44 piles were delivered from landing by train to S. driver.

Messrs. Hansen Mears & Official photographer went through to Kern Cr. and took moving pictures of shovel, dinky trains and drivers. Freezing temp all day cooler tonight with N. wind.

Fri –11-23-17

Drove 20 piles, Scottie hauled piles & put on sway braces & the lower rig drove 30 piles.

Veltrap was layed up with an injured eye. Andy completed fill to bridge but has not quit, expecting to make some fill along the bridge where the slough cut out from the piling. Messrs Hansen & Mears went through on their way back to Anchorage. Yesterday all the party signed a card pledging to ourselves to contribute 25 cts per month for 1 yr or during the war for Red Cross. Tonight Geo Trembly is collecting \$1.00 from everyone in camp to buy tobacco for the soldiers.

Sun shone clear.

Leech had the launch Northern Lts start to tow a raft of pilings to drivers but just about opposite the S. rig the

got stuck in the ice and the launch had to leave the piles & beat it back to the landing.

Sat. -11-24-17

Drove 10 piles Scottie drove 25 & lower rig drove 25

Tide prevented S driver from working after 3 P.M.

Fill at slough near bridge settled about 2 ft today. Norris (asst paymaster in camp) on way to Seward to work in that division. Coulmnan arrived in camp today to act as asst time keeper to take place of North who is going outside.

Clarence came back to camp.

Mrs. Secrest had a birthday party for Bill. She had us come over to entertain the women candy etc.

Fine day. Cloudy.

Sun . -11-25-17

Drove 15 piles Rig worked loging [sic: logging] most of PM Scottie drove 15 P.M. & lower rig 20 Fill across slough settled about four feet today. The tides running under it are washing out the ice it was made on. Snrow? A.M fine P.M.

Mon -11-26-17

Drove 16 piles Scottie drove 5 & riged [sic: rigged] up a haul back line. Lower rig hauled piles.

Snow

Ray worked shoveling out trenches.

Hackal?, Porter & Wilson res. Eng'rs from Talkeetna District went through on way to outside.

Tues. -11-27-17

Drove 19 piles Scottie hauled piles. Lower rig drove 30 piles Mr. Hansen came over the line today. Heard that the booze scandle [sic: scandal] in Talkeetna District caught the whole layout up there. Three books came in mail from Donna?

Cold N. wind all day Temp lowering tonight 7° above at 9 P.M.

Wed. -11-28-17

Transcripts.

High wind from N. W. all day & temp between 5° & 8° above. Wind blowing & colder tonight. The S. rig did not drive Scottie & the lower rig each drove 10 piles. The transit & level blew off the trestle last night. They landed in ice & water *The level was out of adjustment but apparently not seriously hurt. The transit was sprung in three places set screw on the vertical arc was bent. The guard of the vertical arc was also bent and one of the standards was sprung. We straightened it out P.M. but did not adjust it.

Ate dinner at Mrs. Este's which was got up by Mrs.E. & Mrs. Secrest. Mat, Van & 2 from our party & Mr. Roberts the boin? [eom?]boss & Fred Bleckle. were there. Fine Turkey dinner with all the trimings. They had turkey at the Mess House this noon.

Clear & cold all day. 3° above at 8 A.M.

Fri. 11-30-17

2° below zero this A.M.

Veltrop hauled piles ahead Van & I dug out some holes PM. & office A.M. Gang for other rigs in town

Clear & cold all day.

Fill went down again last night. Mr. Leech in camp tonight also Geo Trembly. Mat helping make monthly reports Ray & McDonald working at Secrest house Awbry quit & went to Anchorage after his check.

Made off. to T & A.M.

Clear & cold tonight

Sat -12-1-17

Drove 20 piles. Scottie drove 20 & lower rig drove 15

Cold & clear all day 1° below A.M.

Don Leech in camp tonight.

Swanson's camp move out today. Mr. S. & I had a very animated talk on laborers & their treatment tonight I condemed the lack of consideration they receive here. He admitted it but thought better conditions could not be expected in a temporary camp.

Sun. -12-2-17

Drove 10 piles AM. & dug & staked holes & hauled piles PM. Scottie drove 15 piles & fixup hauling them P.M. Lower rig finished driving & closed lower gap. Mr. S. worked on Monthly estimate all day & tonight. Helped him ck. it tonight.

Rec'd Merchant Stock in tonight & mail.

Cloudy & about 5° to 10° above

moderate tonight

Awbry Bros. got back from town & went on to 71 P.M. North left with Tom Haines & Bill Hudson for Seward & Outside, PM.

Mon. -12-3-17

Drove 30 piles. Scottie hauled piles & the lower rig hauled stringers ahead. Cold & clear all day.

Bill Jinecky came back from Kern Cr. on his way to Potter & got dinner here. Andy hauled piles out to trestle.

Drove 30 piles Scottie drove 35. Lower rig got set out on false work beside trestle. Messrs. Hansen & Leech were in camp & went toward Potter tonight

Tonight's paper announced the serial numbers of the registered men and that the drawing would probably take place about Jan. 15th Matt says he is going to quit next week &

go out to enlist before he can be drafted.

Fine day cloudy.

Thur. -12-6-17

Drove 15 piles. Scottie drove 20 Both hauled piles part of the day. Lower outfit worked on decking.

Mat & McDonald set B. M. at ends of cuts.

Cloudy, Moderate.

Fri. 12-7-17

Drove 25 piles Scottie drove 15 which completed the trestle. They also started to driver piles on which to set the drivers out. Matt & McDonald ran levels.

Mr. Leech said tonight that Mr. Hansen is to take Mr. Mears place in Anchorage while he goes to Washington & that the District Office will move to Anchorage.

Matt went to Anchorage A.M. Ray helped Rolf Davis run centers on the bridge.

Finished +sec't'g at bluff & reset one hub in McCormicks cut. Mat left for Seward & the outside to join the Army.

A big bunch went through for the outside, among them was Max Kinney so McDonald said. K. K. Kiney? is on his way out.

Thur. 12-13-17

Put in CL [centerline] points in McCormicks cut & fill Cold & cloudy all day.

Fri. 12-14-17

Ran CL [centerline] points from 1606 to 1614. Herb Davis & family came in today & are to be located here this winter. What will happen to me no one seems to know but from what Herb says I will be left on the roll in some capacity.

Am not worrying & will let things take their course. Tom McKinney & Dan Leech in camp tonight. Probably coldest day of year.

14° below at Bird Cr. at 2 P.M.

Sat. -12-15-17

Ran CL & line into McCormicks coyote.

Ralph Kinney, Connelly & Jack Taylor are here tonight on their way outside. It seems that a big shake up is taking place in Anchorage as well as on the line & a lot of men are being let out.

This was another very cold day.

He stated that the party at camp 86 would be the same size & that Kelsey would probably be the instman there. As the news of the cuts in the parties spreads, all the boys are looking down cast.

Very cold & windy. Magnus in camp tonight

Sat. 12-22-17

MacDonald, Ray & I came to Anchorage. Walked to Falls Cr. & took train from there. Tonight went up to visit Miss Watts. Was there from 10 PM to 2 A.M.. She's the same all girl. Headstrong & not one to get all with Americans. She caters to foreigners. 35° below zero in town.

Sun. 12-23-17

Around town most of the day. Called at Mr. Thompson's. about 35° below tonight
