Agency history and functions

The ACC Institutional Planning Committee began in 1984 to outline ACC's strategic goals from 1985-1990. The plan was called, "Blueprint for Action," and completed in 1986. The Institutional Planning Committee had numerous task forces composed of ACC employees and community members. Institutional Planning Committee members served as liaisons to task forces. Each task force tackled an issue that would affect the growth and success of ACC. Examples of the task forces are technology, arts, image, and education. In October, 1986, the announcement was made that UA,A and ACC would merge. As a result, the "Blueprint for Action," was never fully implemented.
