

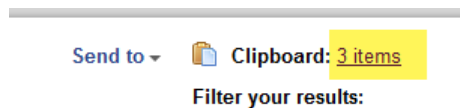
Moving Citations from PubMed to RefWorks

A. Steps in PubMed

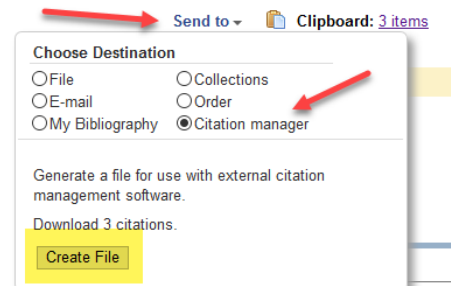
1. Run your search in PubMed
2. Click the box by each article then click **Send to** the Clipboard, then **Add to Clipboard**



3. Open the Clipboard (click on the highlighted link)

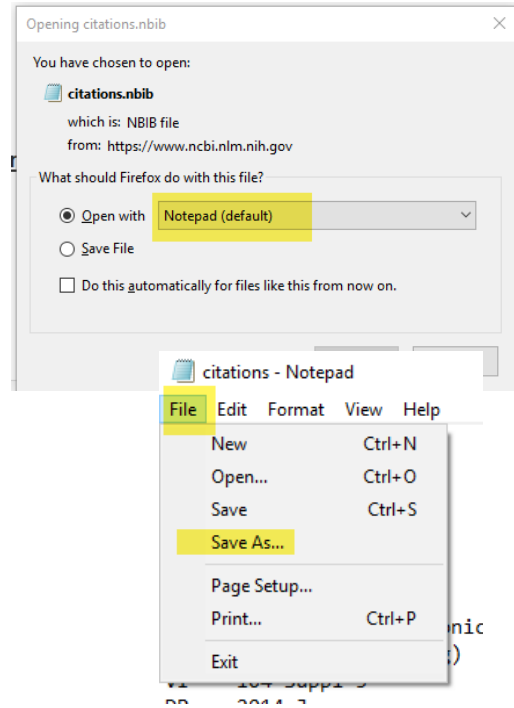


4. Open **Send to**, click **Citation manager**, then click **Create File**

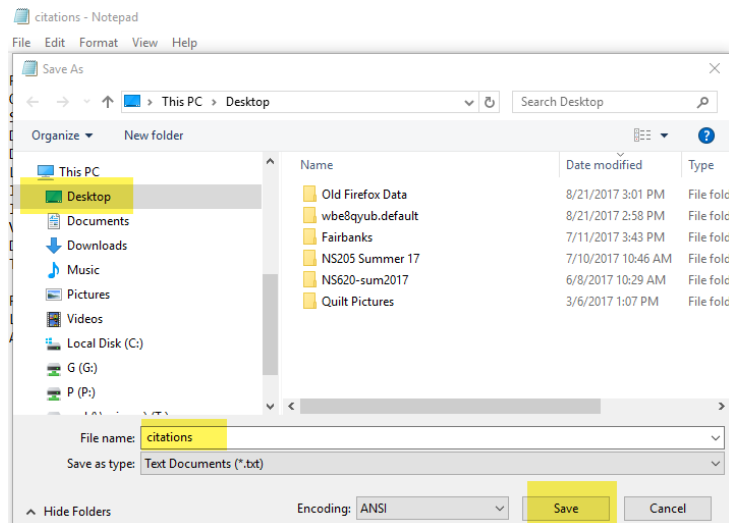


5. A pop-up box will appear. Choose to **Open with** and then choose **Notepad** from the options. Click **Ok**.

6. A list of citations will appear. Choose **File** then **Save As**.

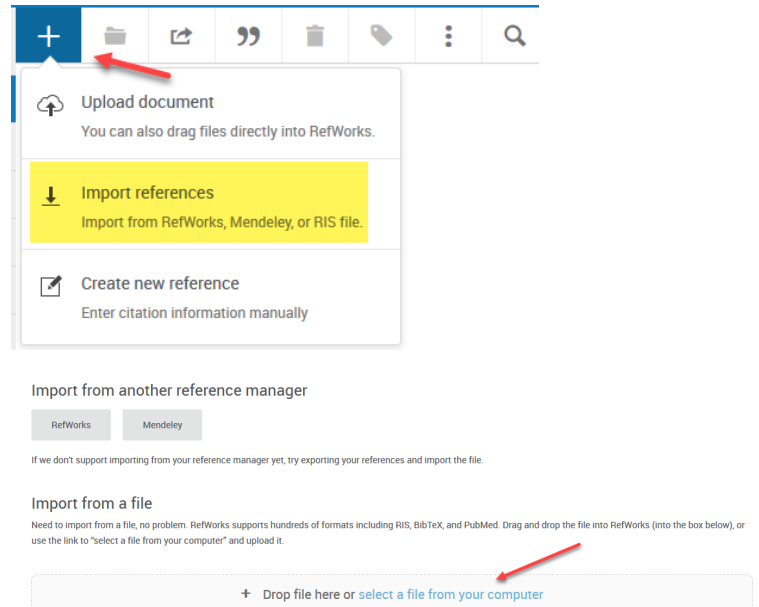


7. Use the file name provided or modify. Click **Save**.



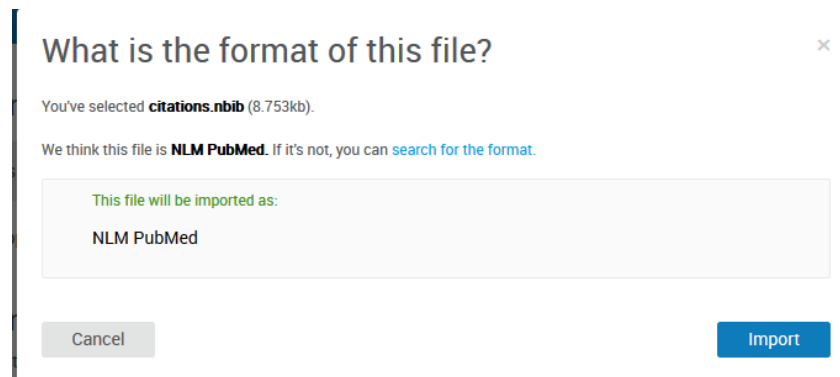
B. Steps in RefWorks

1. Open RefWorks
2. Click the **Plus** sign in the tool bar
3. Choose **Import References**
4. Choose **select a file from your computer**



5. Find the file you saved. Click on the **file** and click **Open**.

6. You should see this pop up



7. Click the **Import** button. Click continue if you get a Security Warning.

8. RefWorks will display an Import complete page. Click **Ok** to see the list of references.
