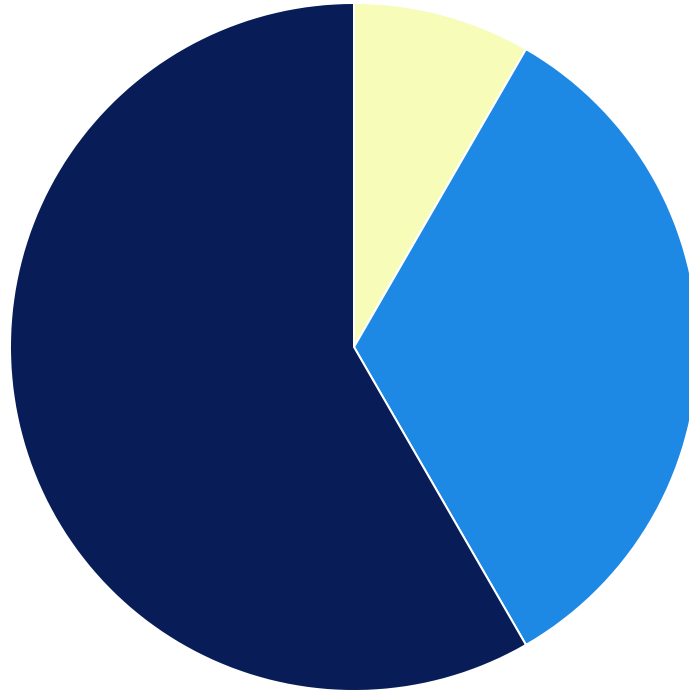

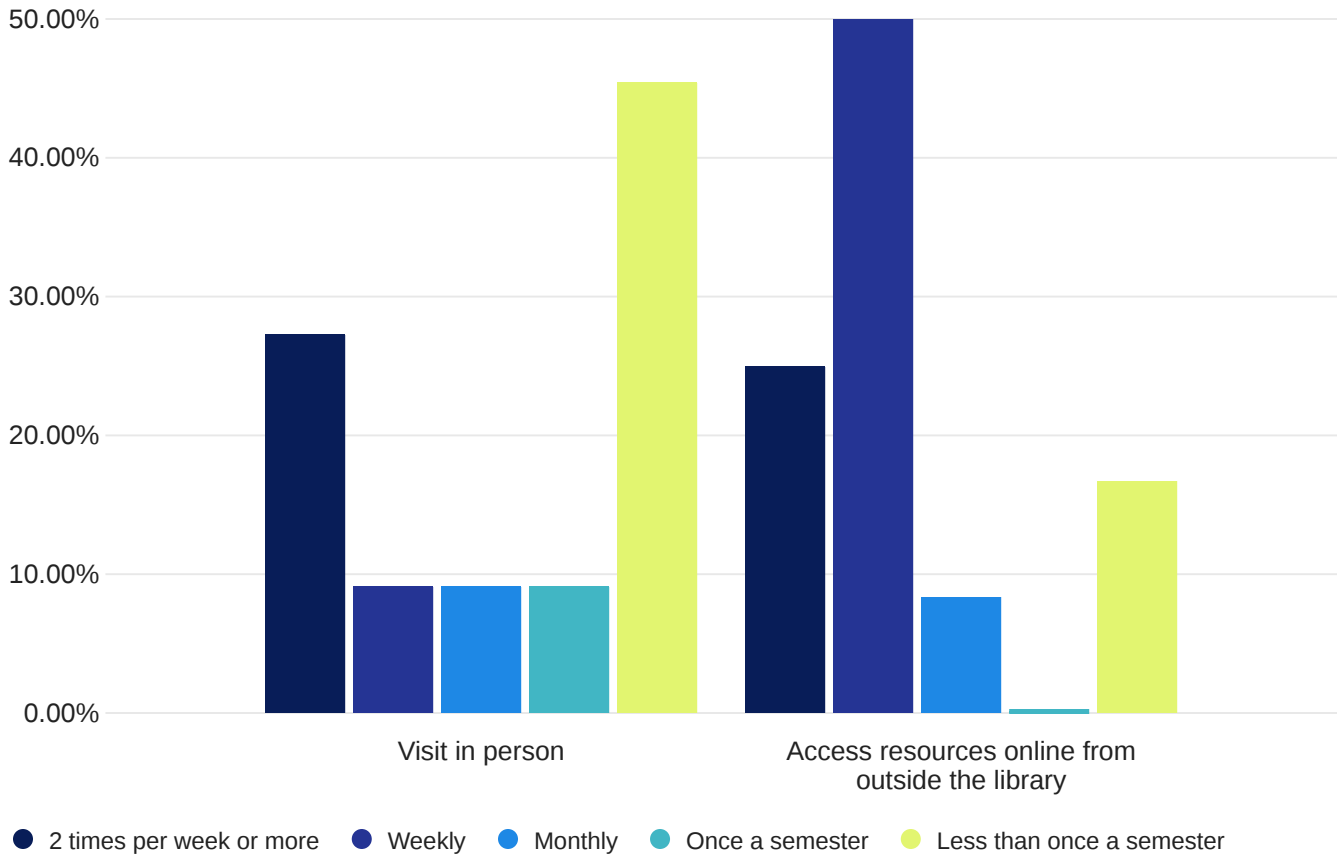

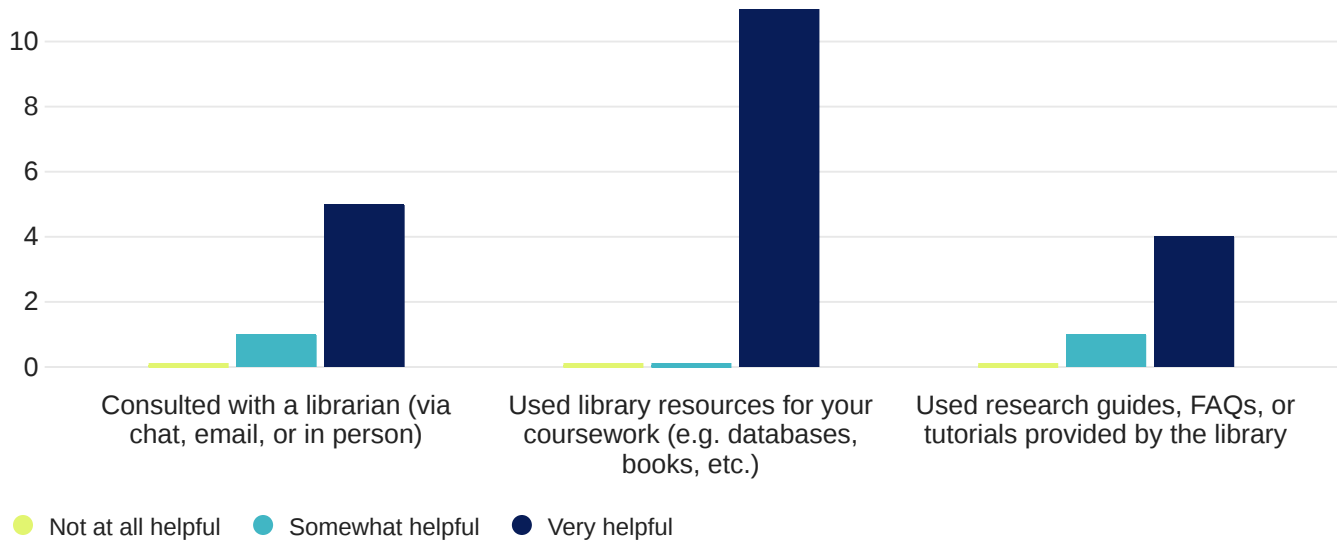
# L1 - How frequently do you VISIT the Consortium Library or ACCESS Consortium Library resources?

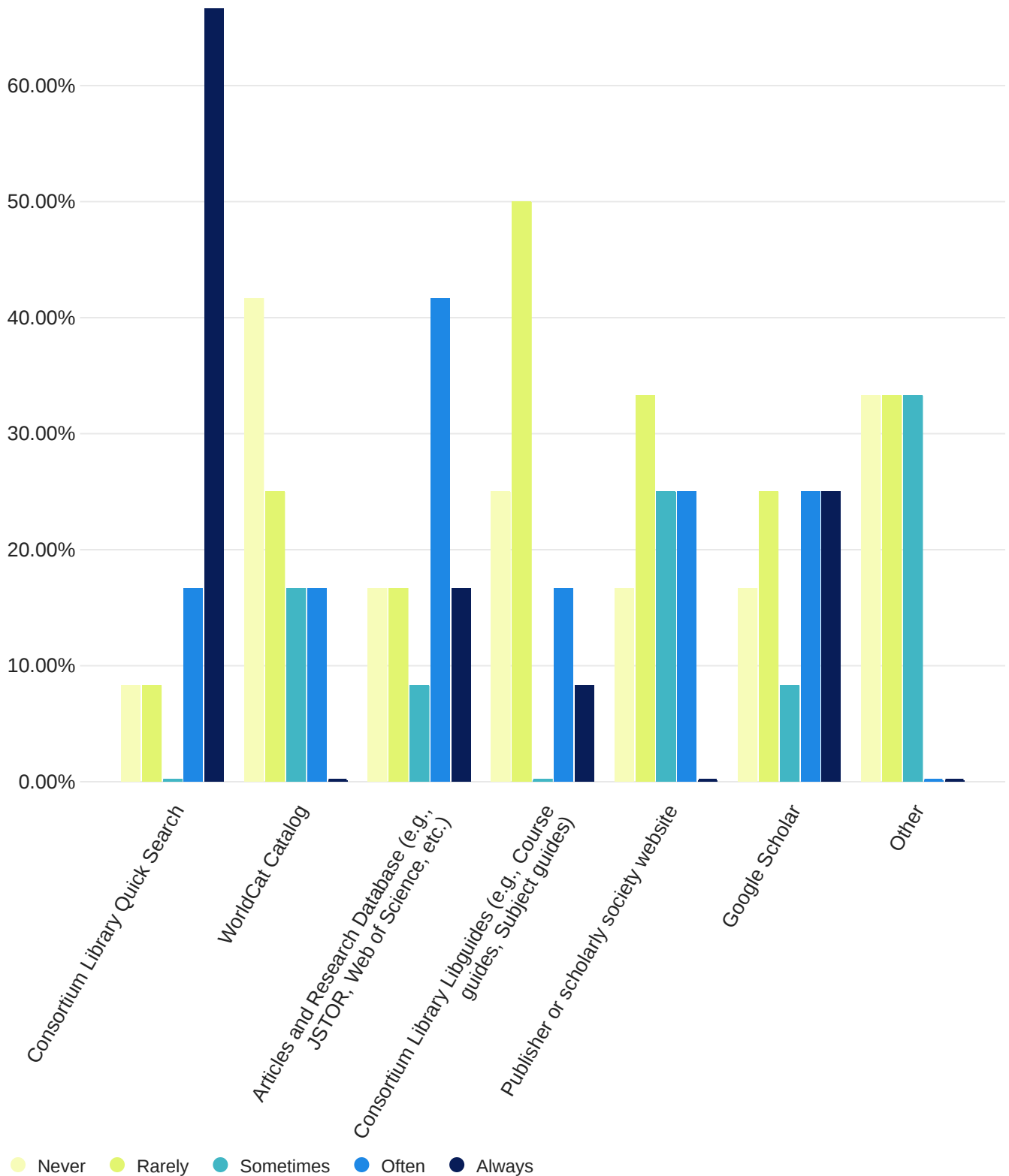

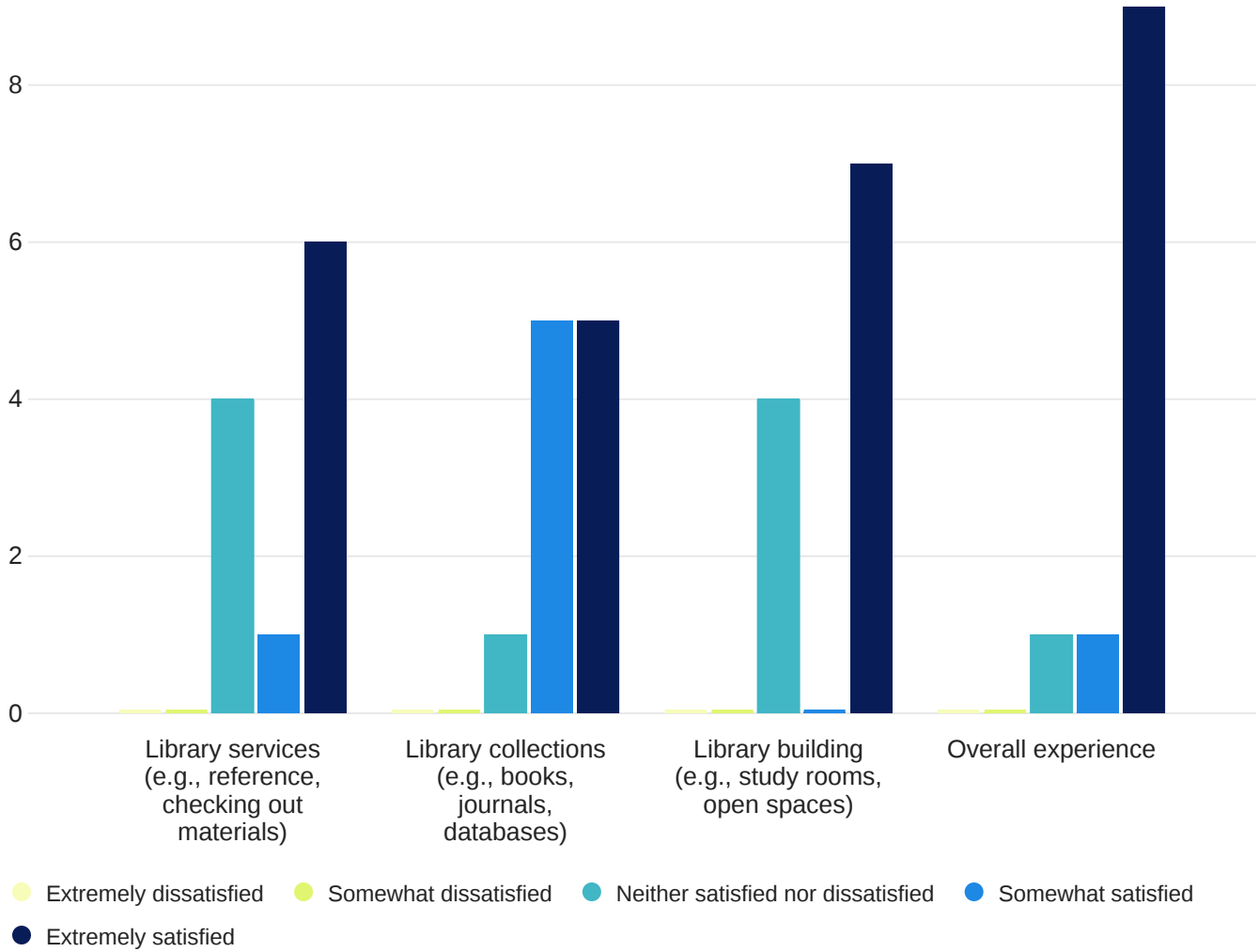
