UD4 - What is your level of study?







UD8 - What is your age range?





UD9 - Do you identify as having a disability?






L1 - How frequently do you VISIT the Consortium Library or ACCESS Consortium Library resources?



UL2 - Which of the following resources do you use most frequently when you are researching a topic for a class assignment? (Please select your top 2 choices)





UL3 - How helpful are the following library spaces and equipment to your academic success?






