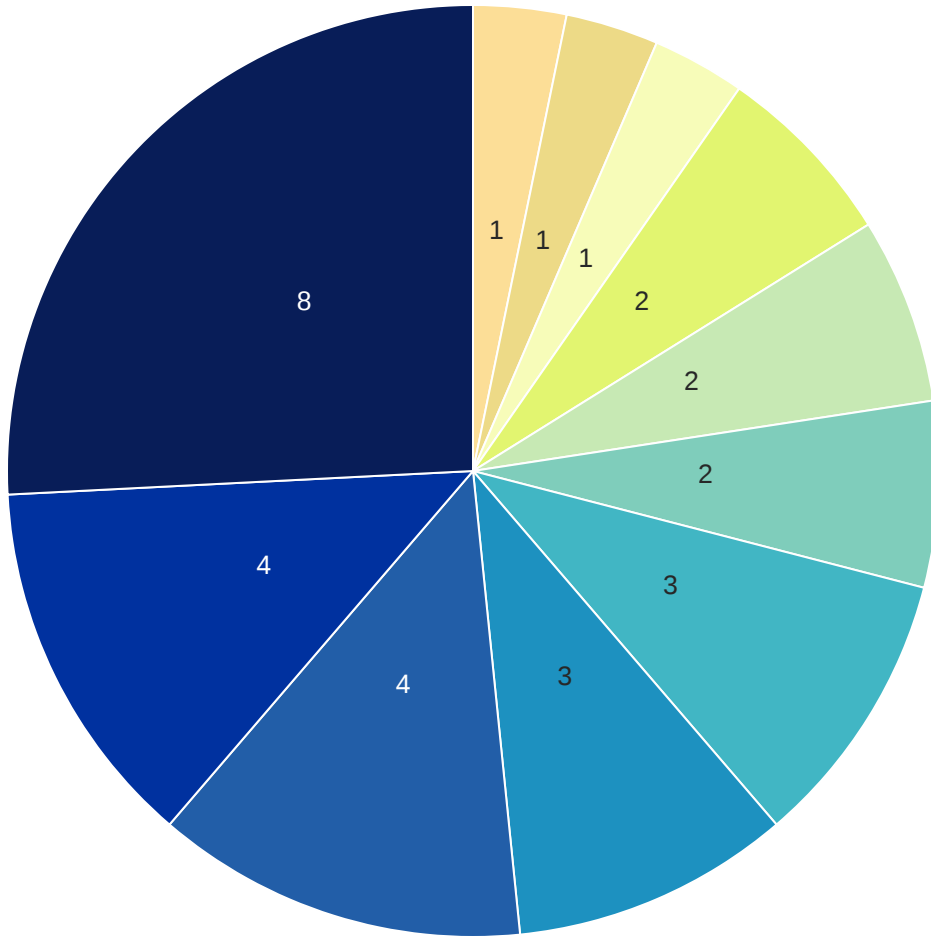

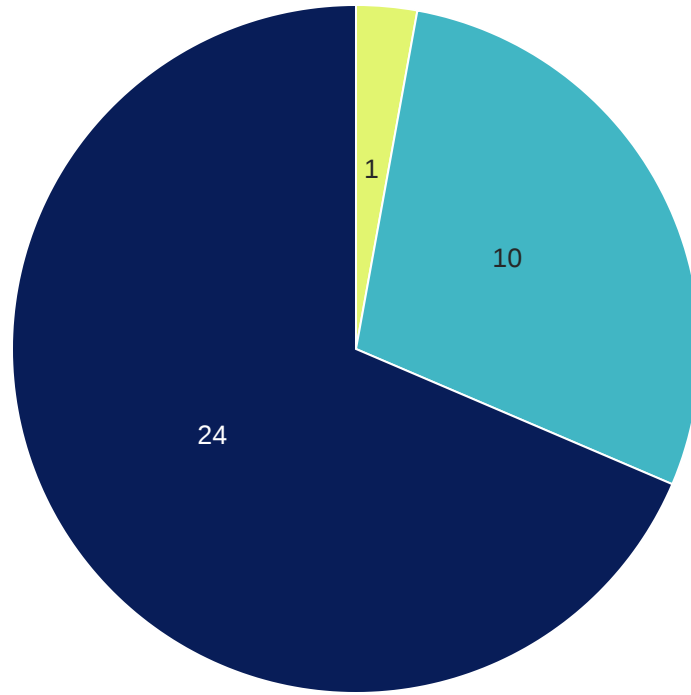

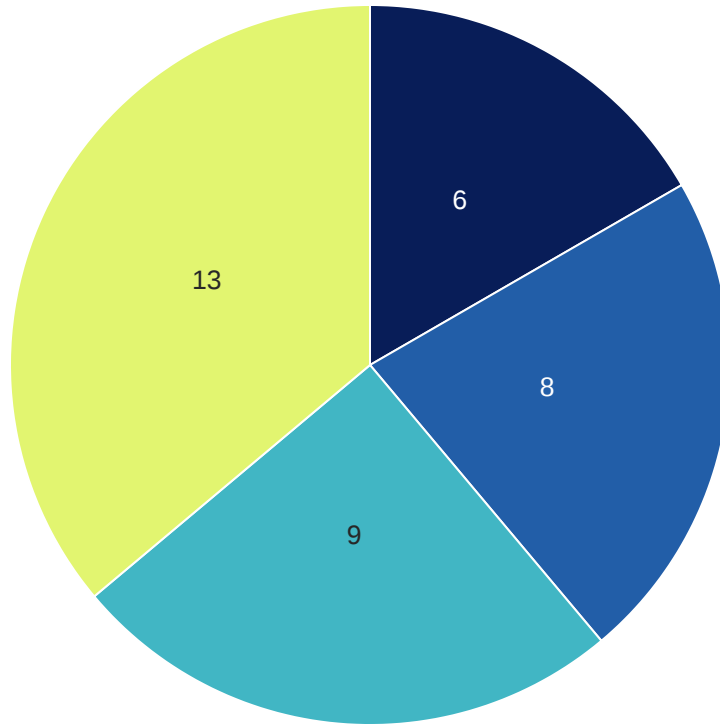

UD4 - What is your level of study?

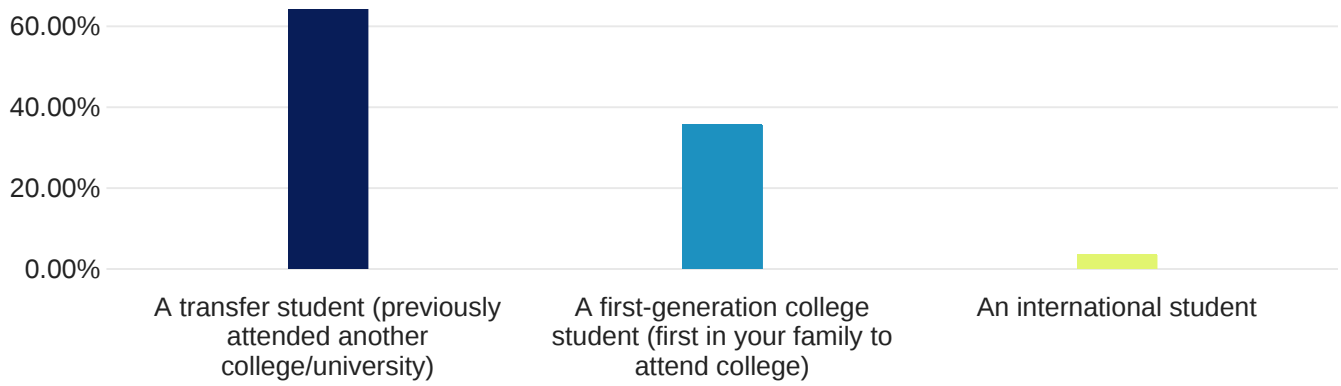

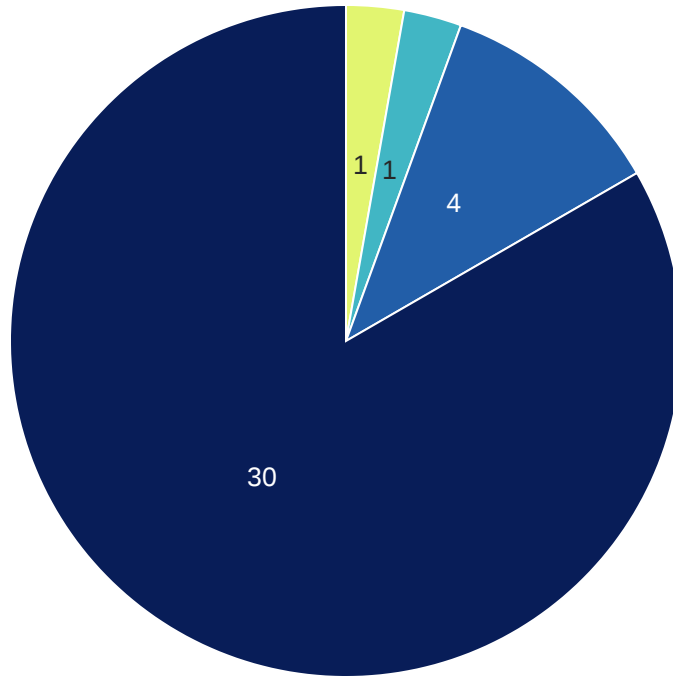

UD6 - Where do you reside

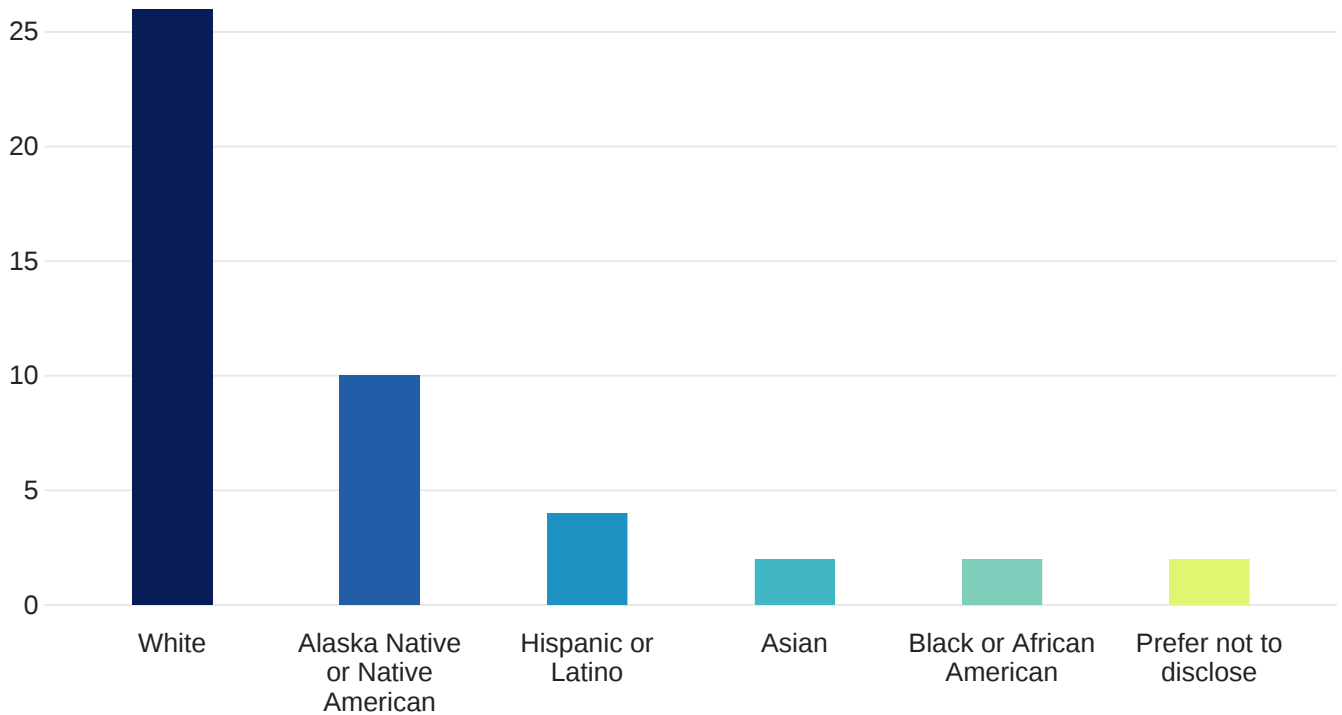

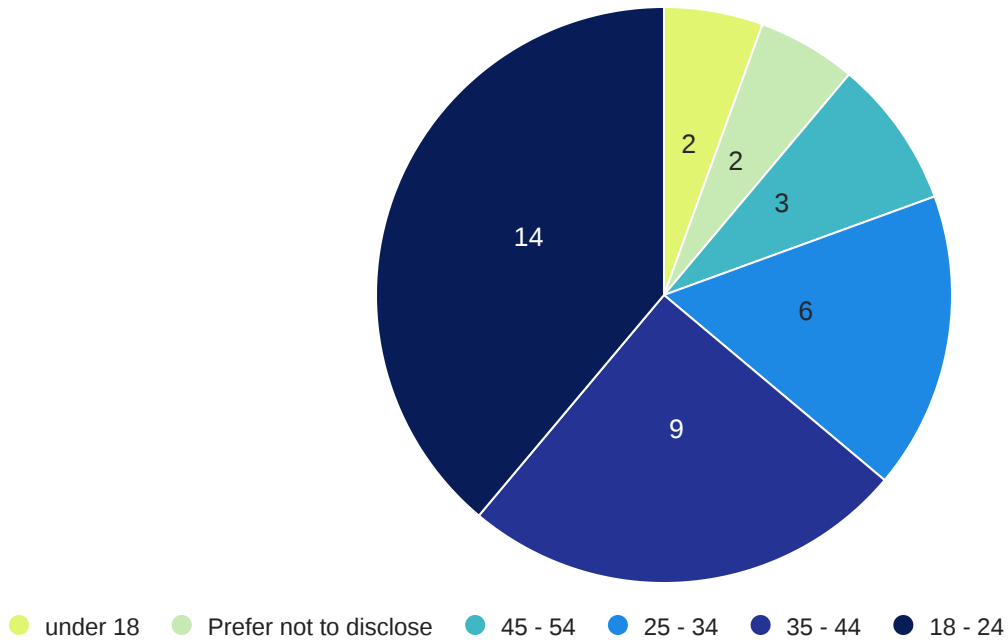

UD8 - What is your age range?

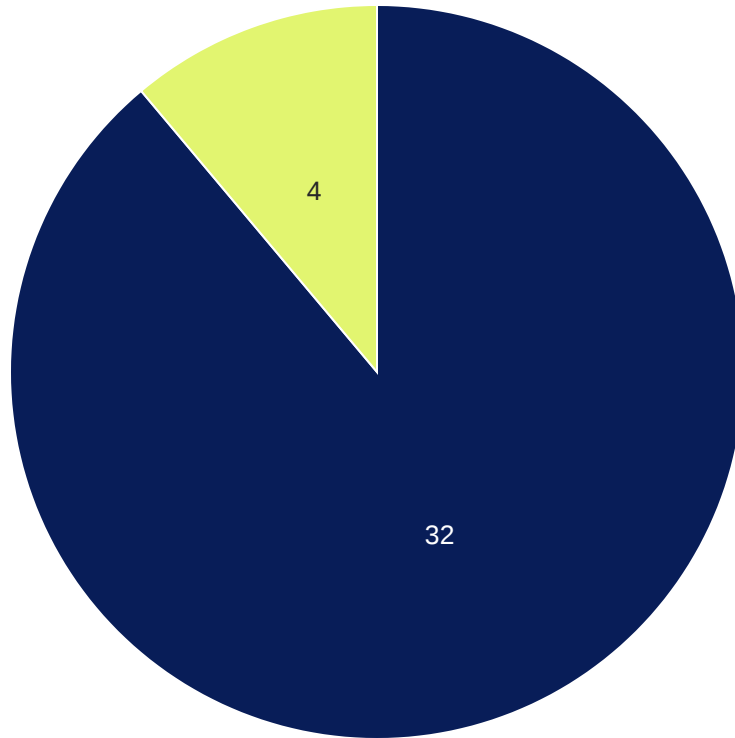

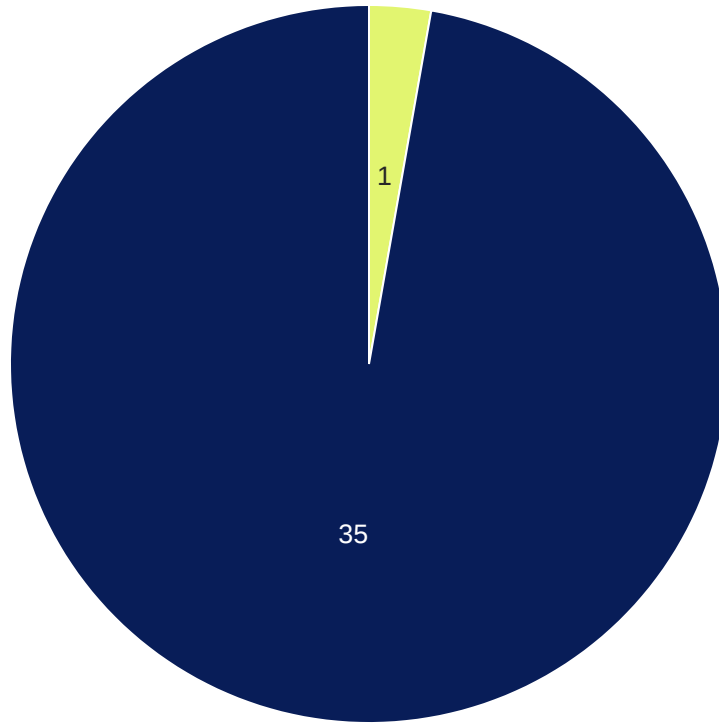

UD10 - Do you need special accommodations to access the Consortium Library?

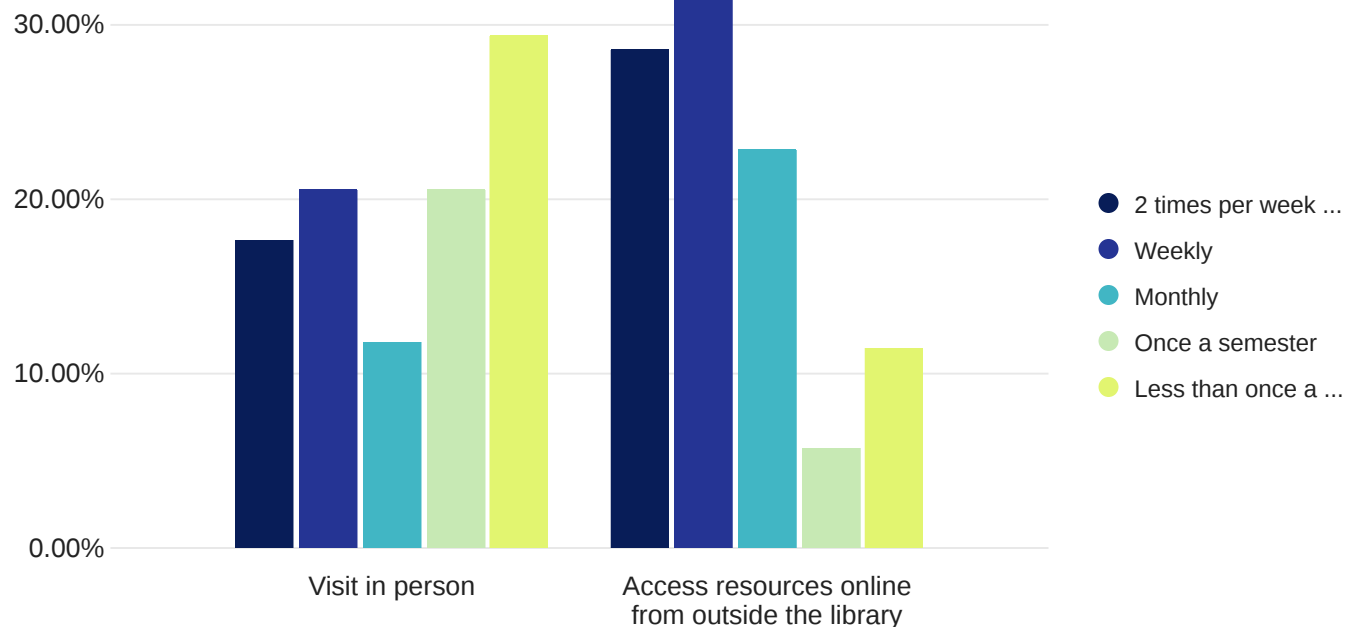

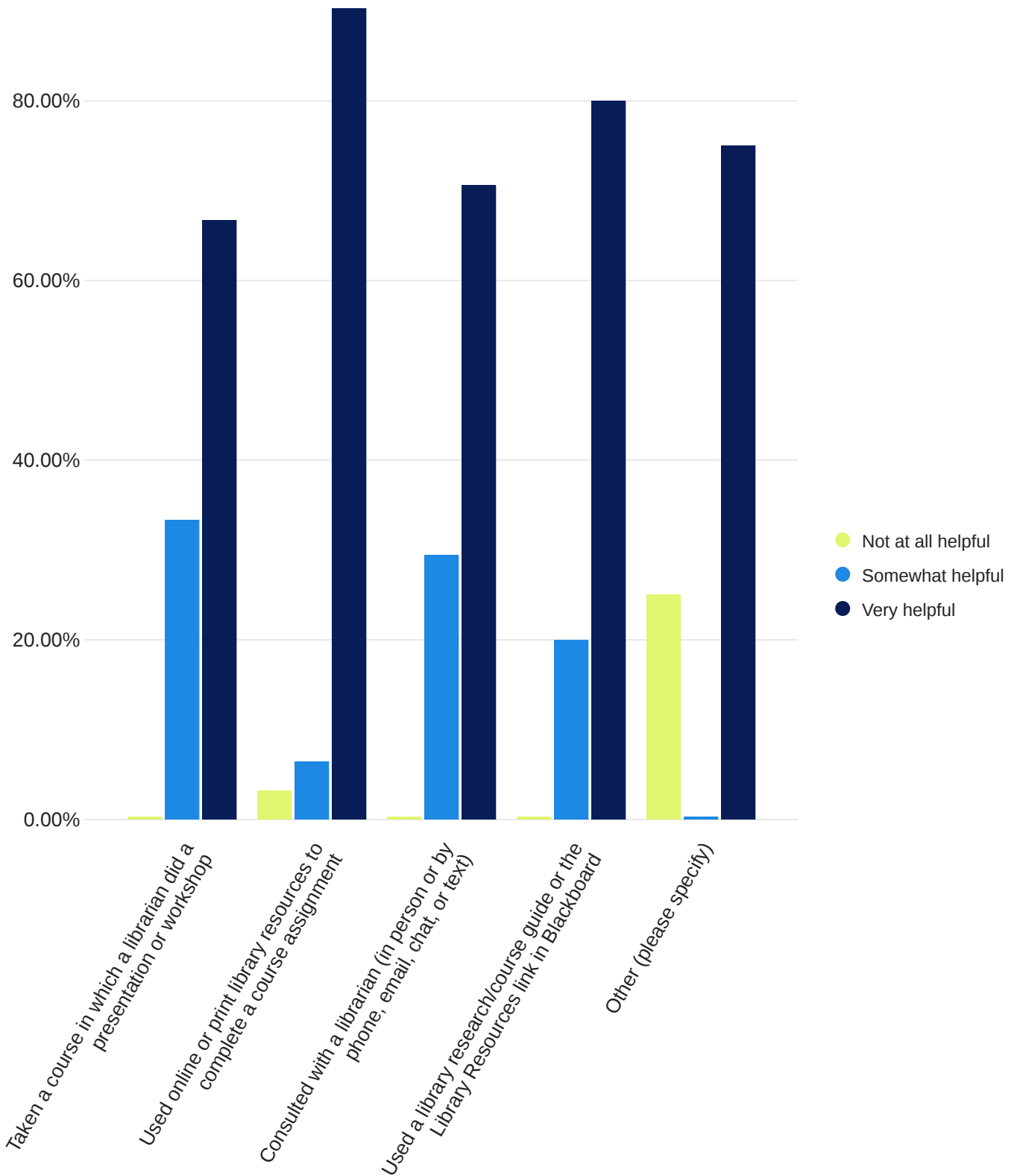
L1 - How frequently do you VISIT the Consortium Library or ACCESS Consortium Library resources?

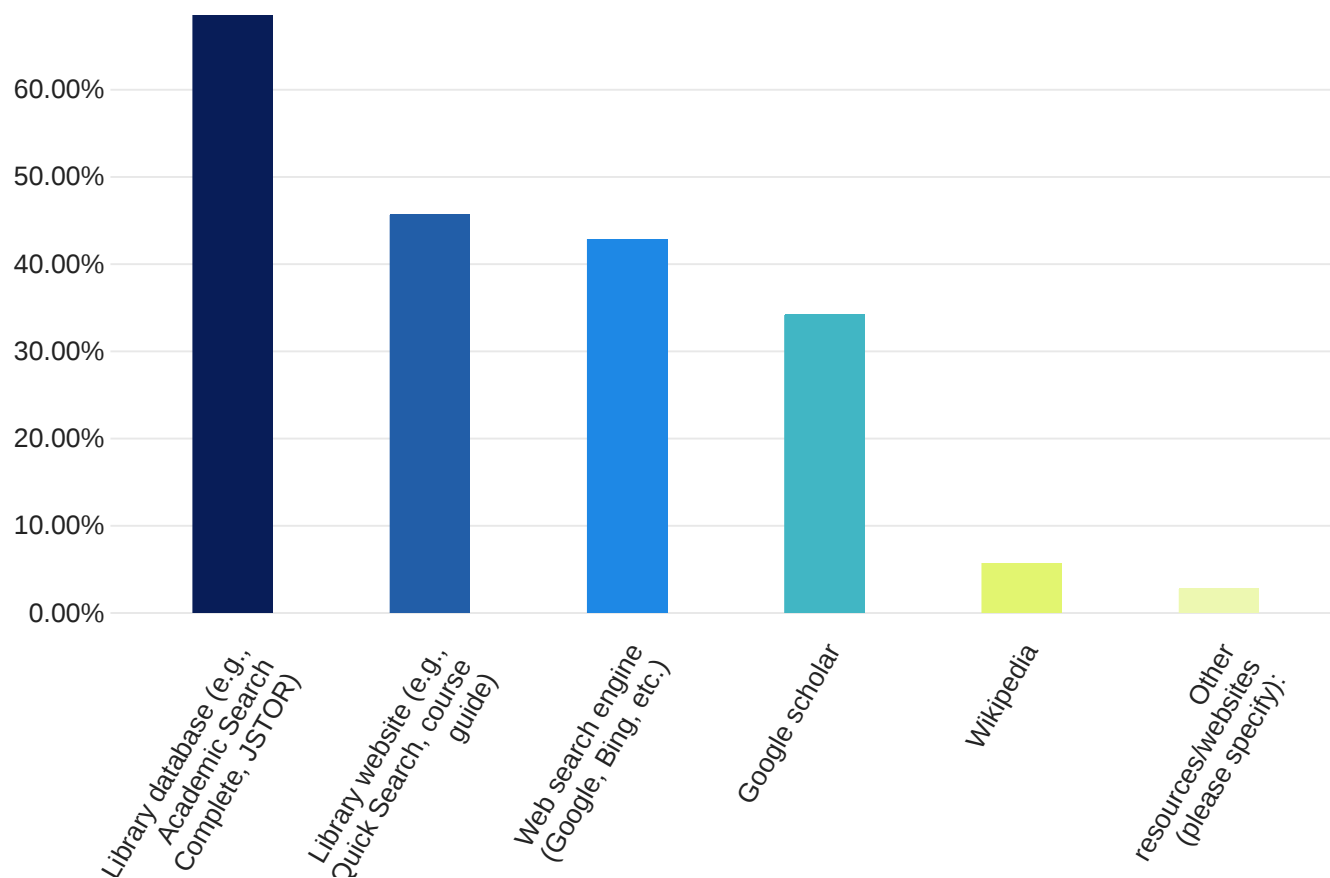

UL2 - Which of the following resources do you use most frequently when you are researching a topic for a class assignment? (Please select your top 2 choices)

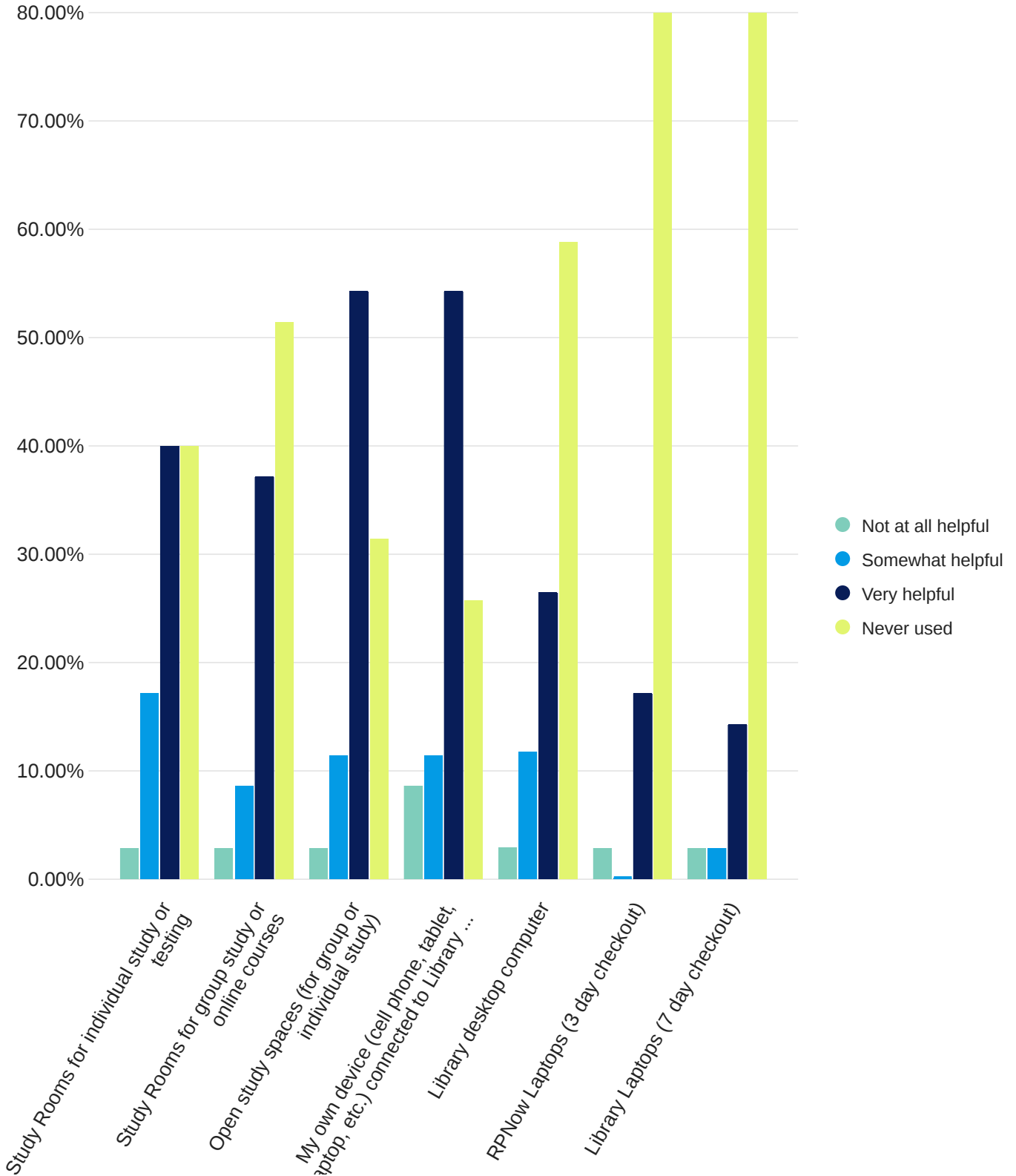

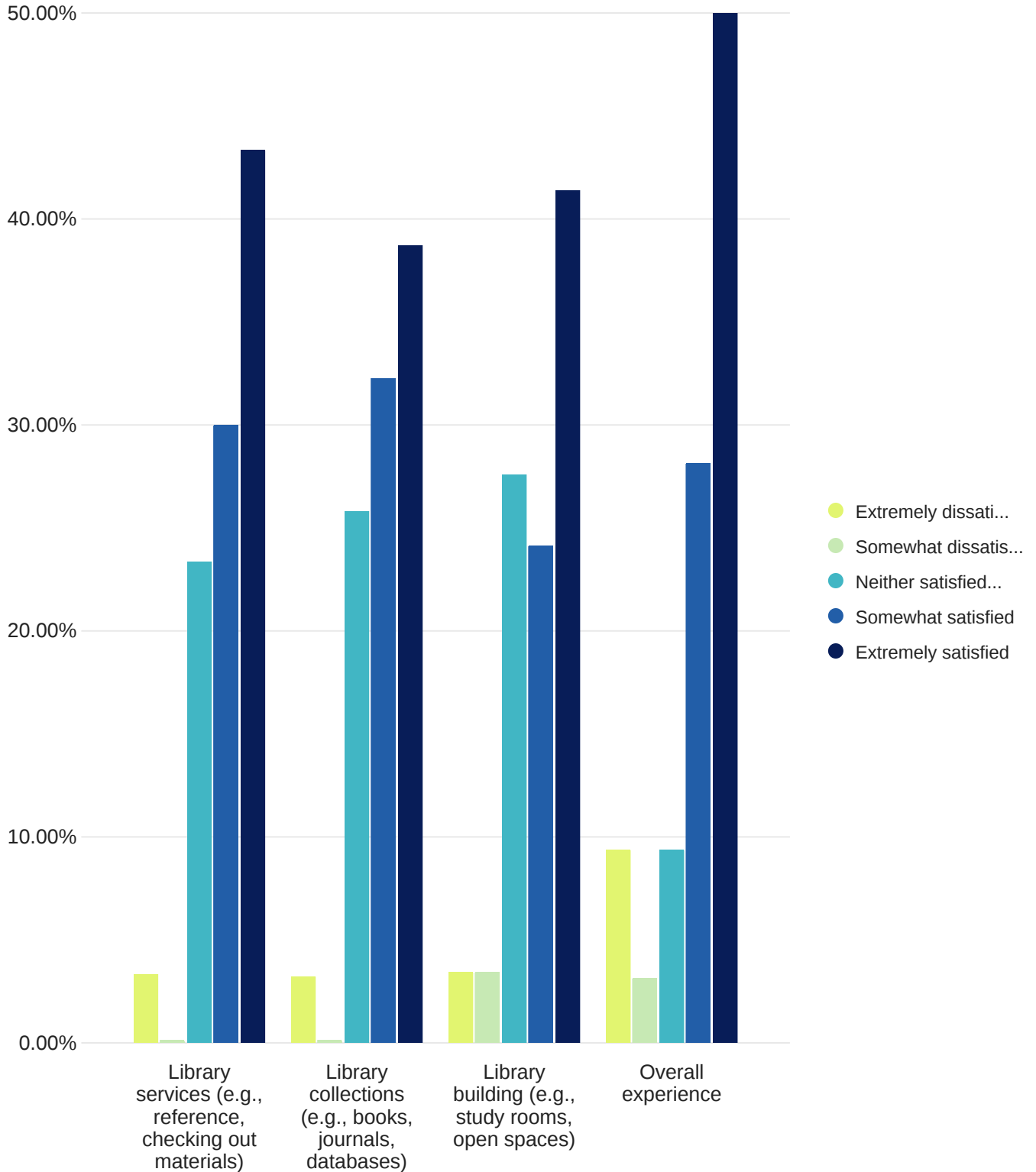
W1 - How helpful do you find the Consortium Library website for...?
