




FD2 - What is your academic title? (Faculty only)


L1 - How frequently do you VISIT the Consortium Library or ACCESS Consortium Library resources?



SL1 - In the past year have you done any of the following? (Select all that apply) (Staff only)






FL4 - If you have a choice between books in print and electronic format, which do you prefer to use?





I am unsure as I have not explored the resource enough to understand what is offered.



FL8 - Are you interested in assistance with identifying materials for course content/course readings (e.g., finding open educational resources or textbooks)?





FL9 - While teaching your courses, did you...




