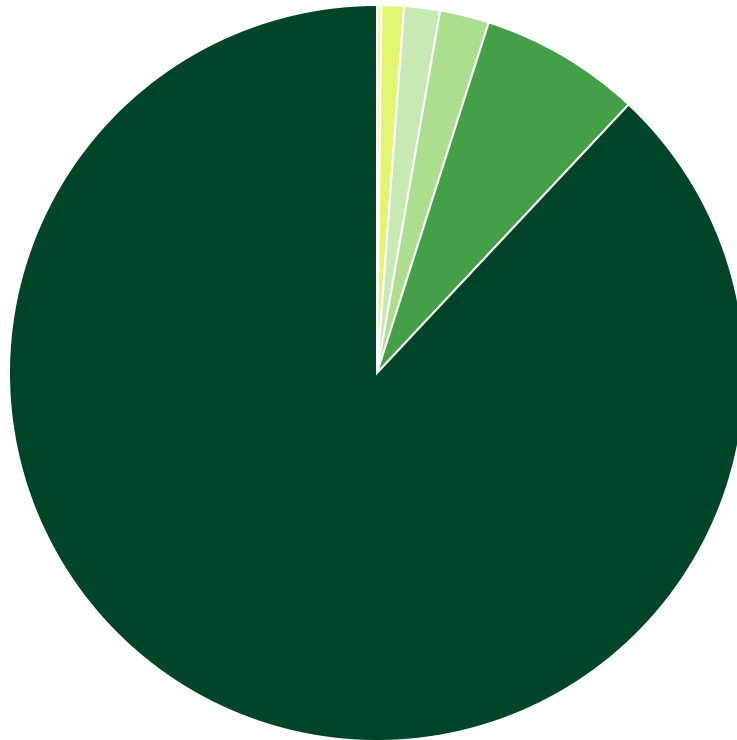


B1a - Which campus are you affiliated with?

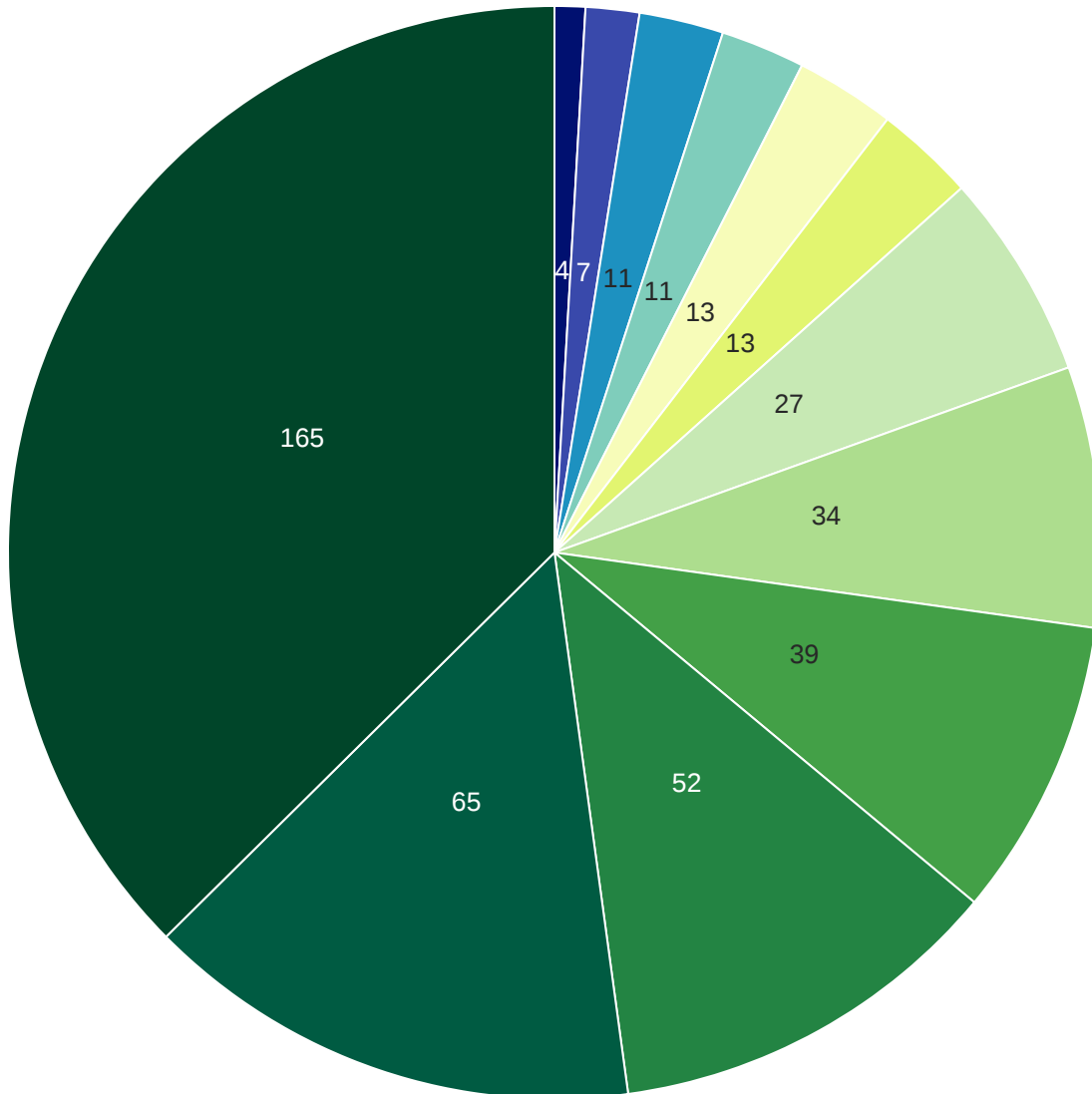

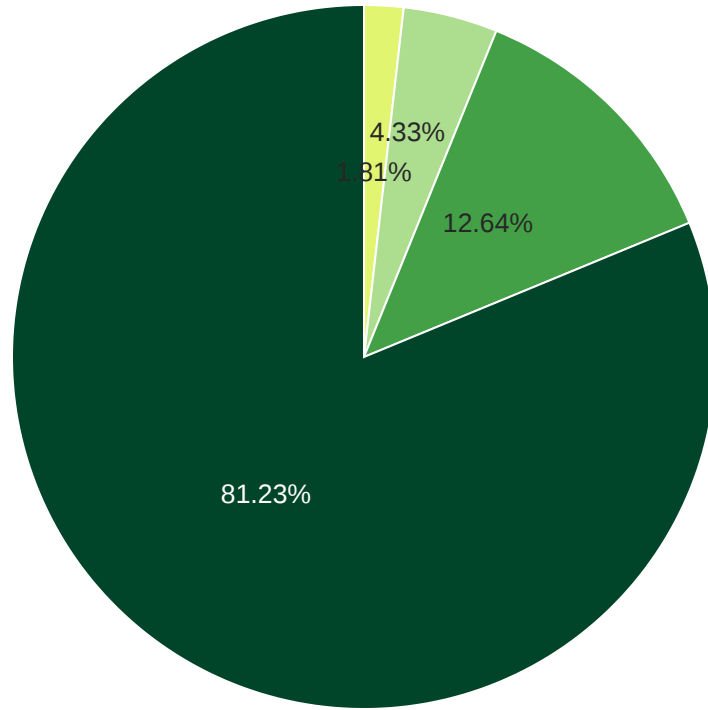

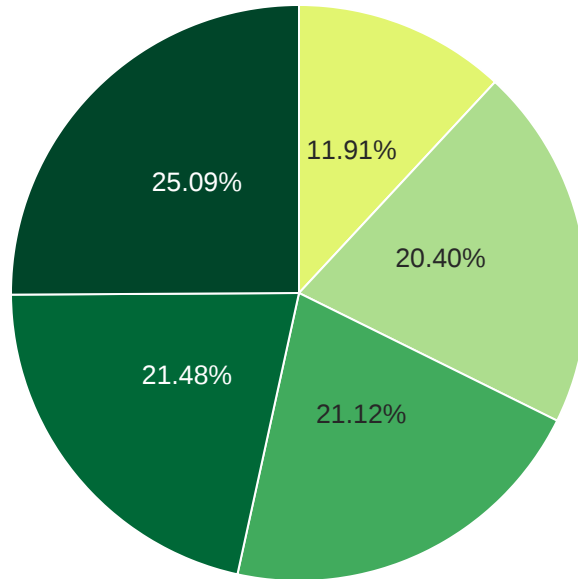

UD4 - What is your level of study?

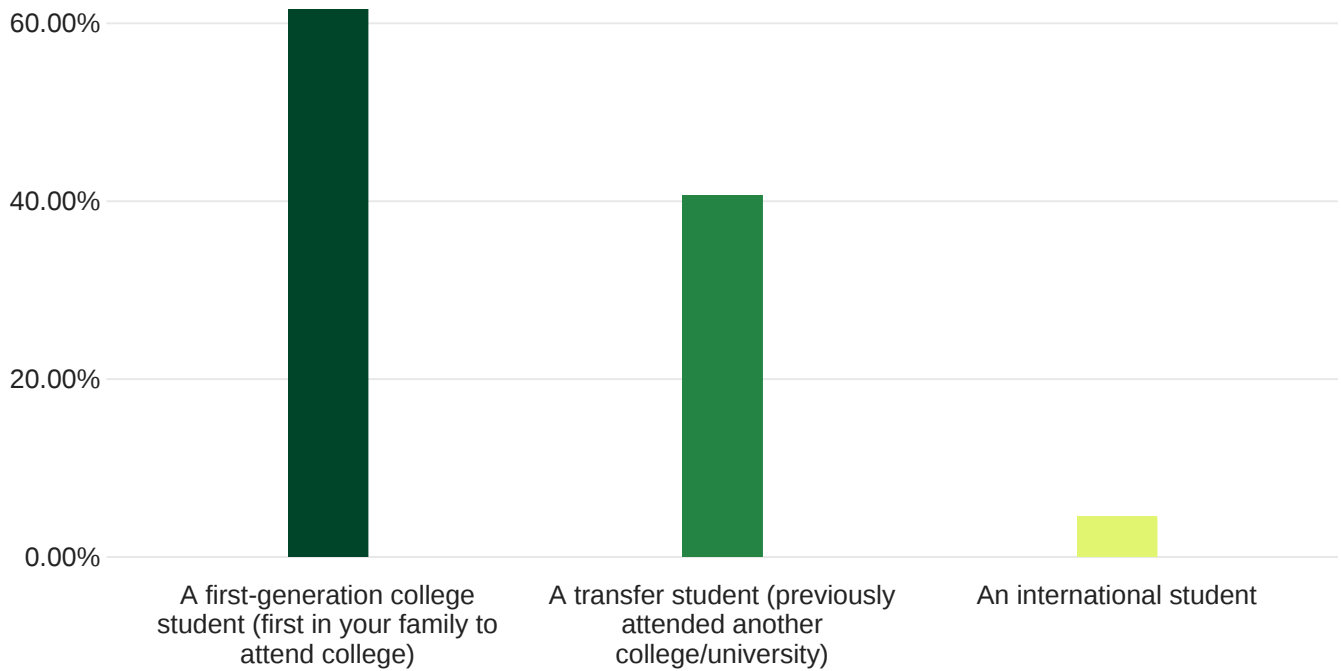

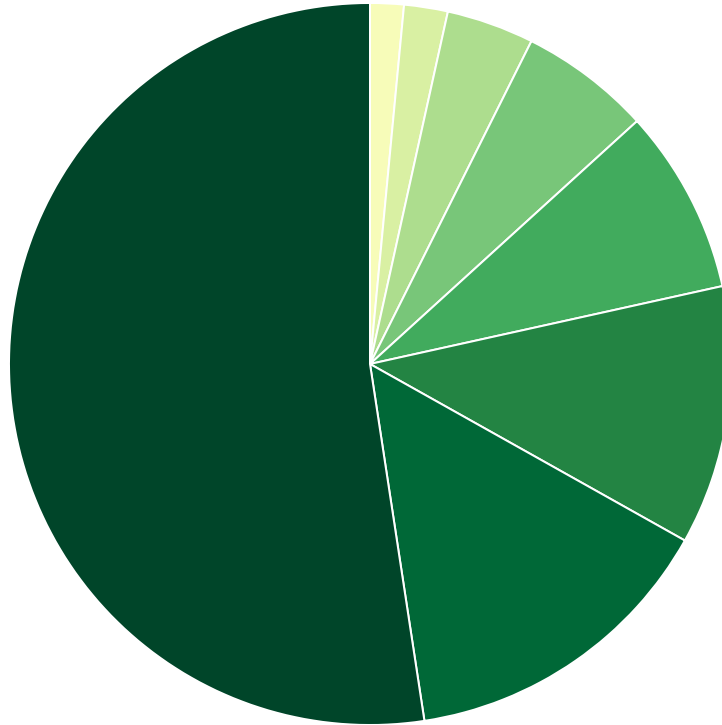

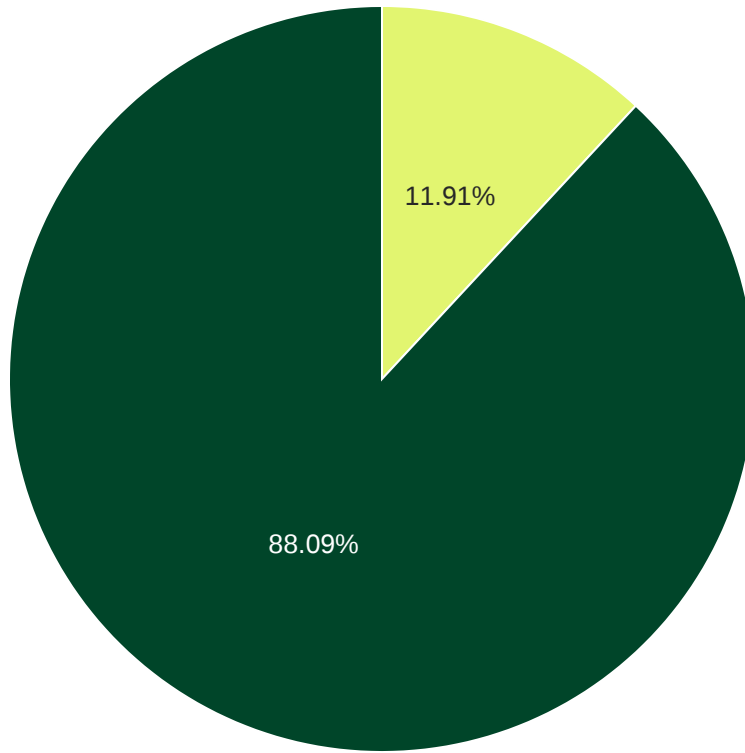

UD10 - Do you need special accommodations to access the Consortium Library?

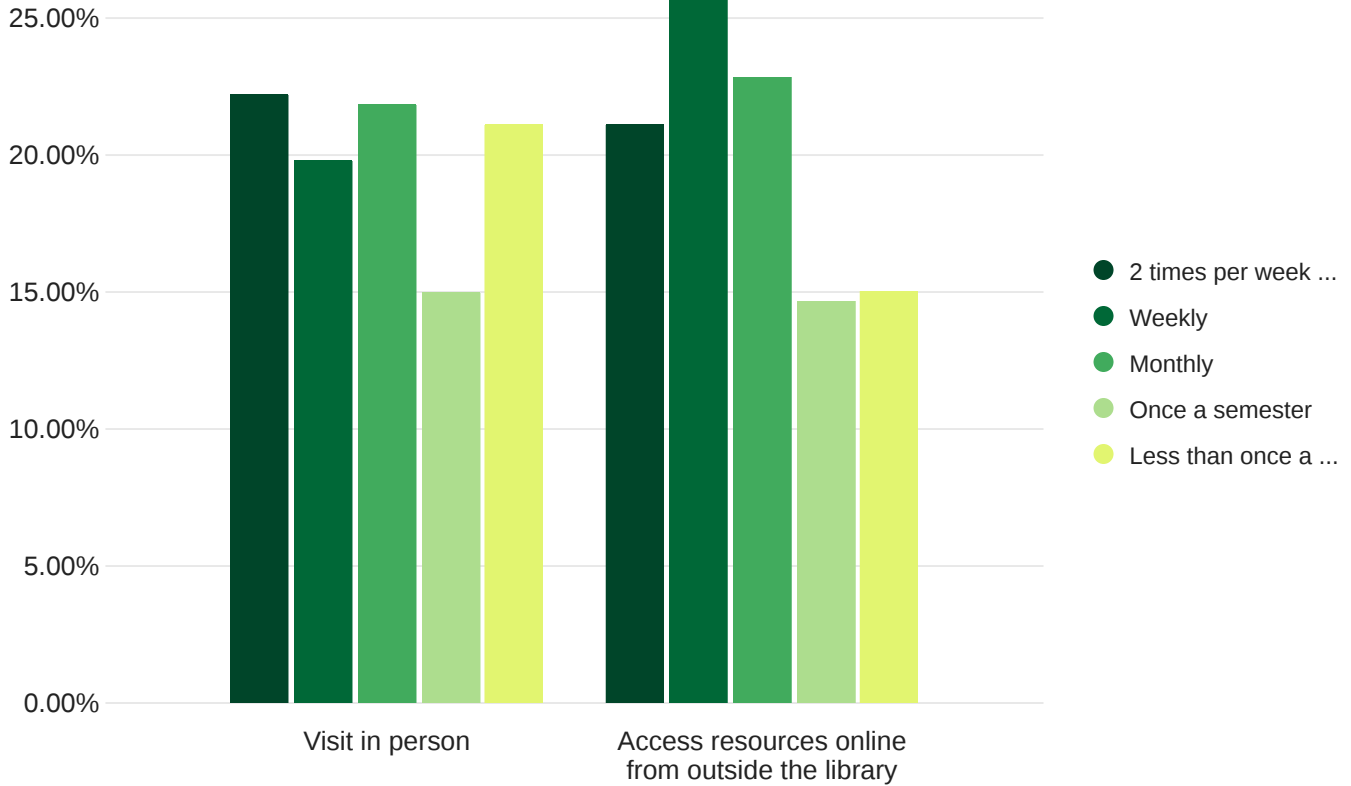

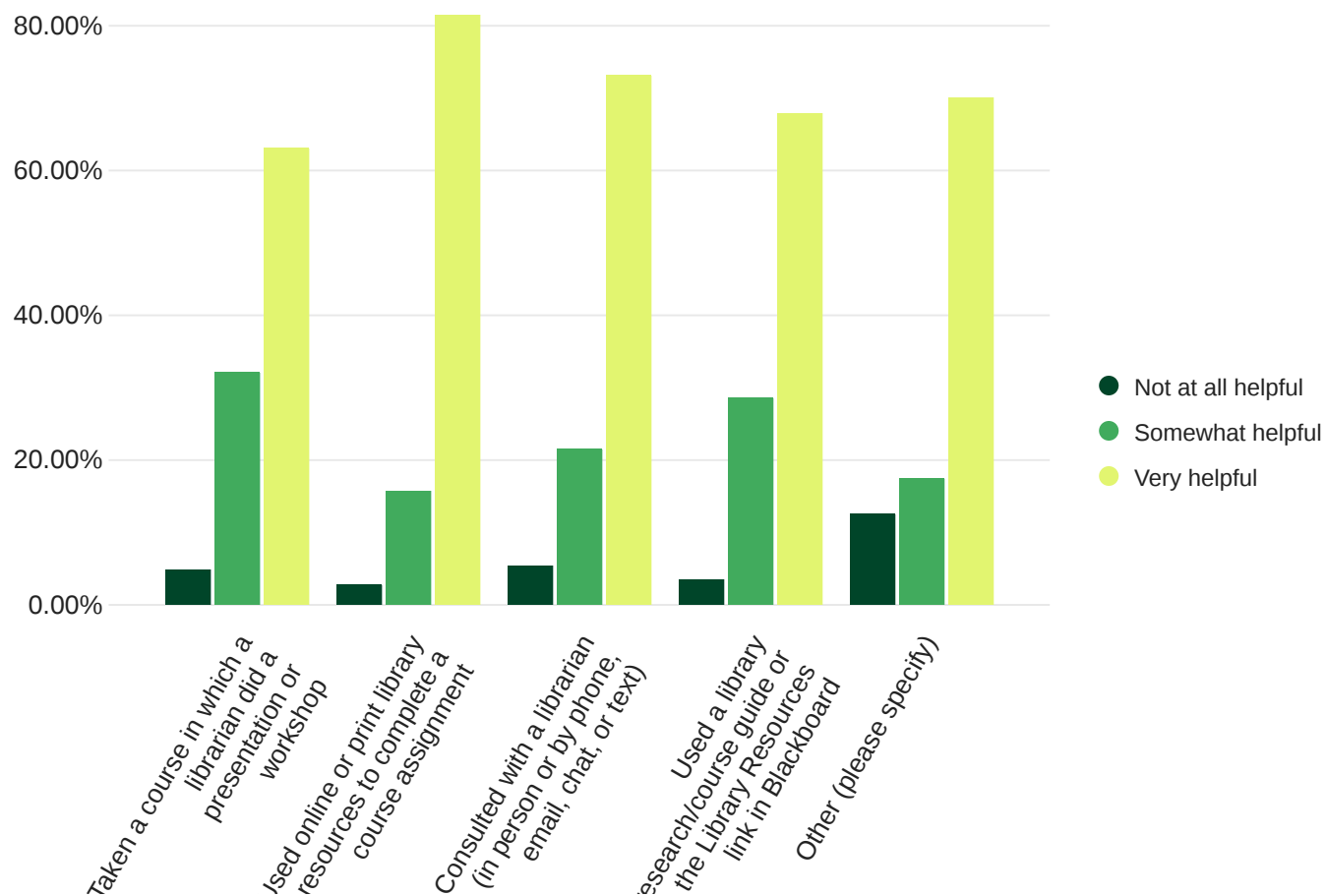
L1 - How frequently do you VISIT the Consortium Library or ACCESS Consortium Library resources?

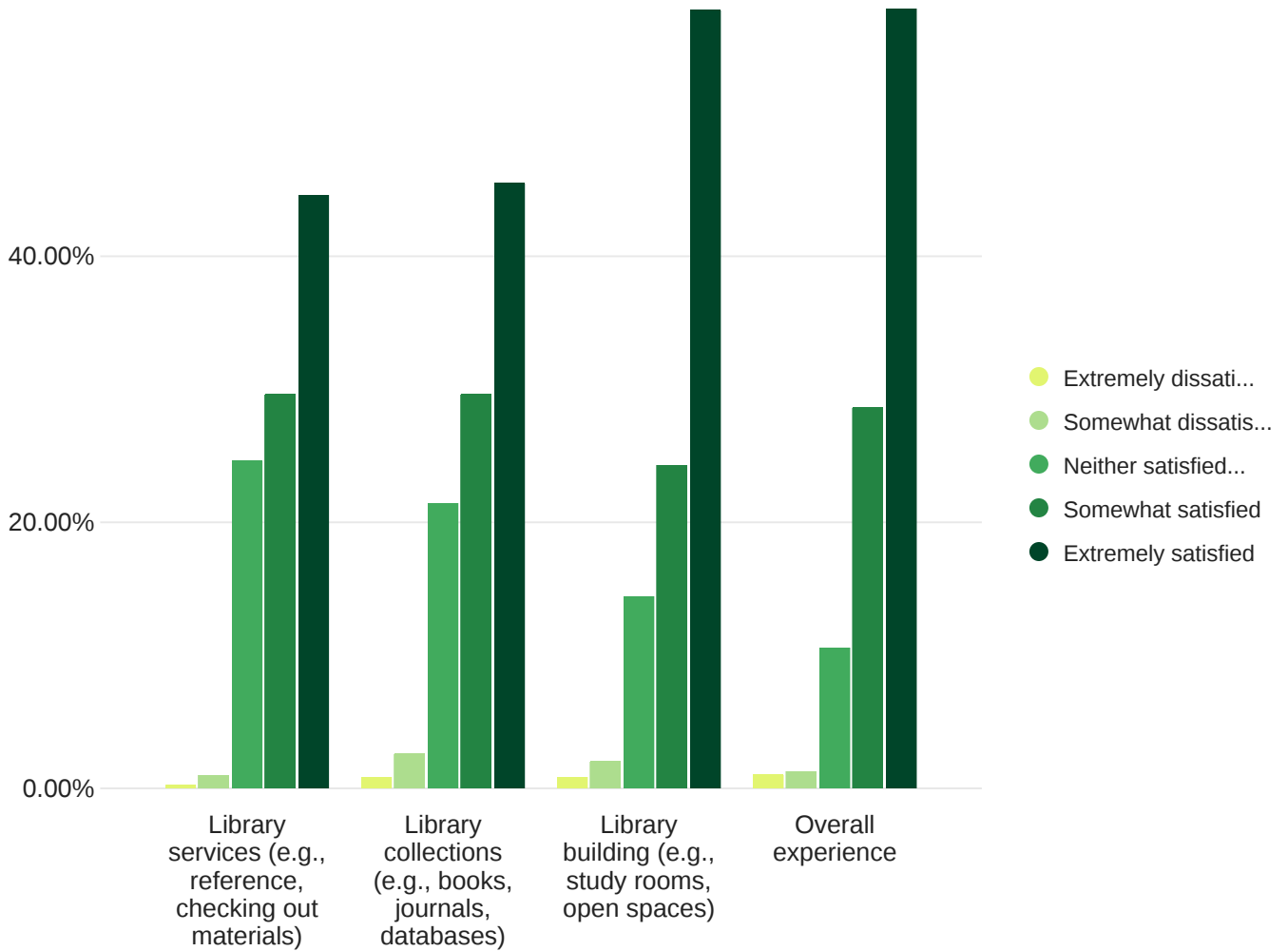
W1 - How helpful do you find the Consortium Library website for...?
